

Skënder (Hyd) Krasniqi

(born 5/02/1953, Albanian from Negroc/
Negrovce, Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality,
construction worker, five children)

Serb forces attacked **Negroc/Negrovce** on **25 September 1998**, which forced Skënder's family to leave their homes and take shelter in the neighbouring village of Vuçak/Vučak. Skënder, however, decided to stay behind. On the evening of 29 September 1998, his family heard on the radio the he had been killed in Negroc/Negrovce the same day they left the village. Skënder's body was found by a local man, Halim Krasniqi, near the spot called *Shpati i Lazes/Lazino brdo (Laza's Hill)*. Skënder's family returned to Negroc/Negrovce on 29 September 1998 and buried Skënder that same day in the cemetery of the *Krasniqi* neighbourhood in Negroc/Negrovce. After the war, on 4 September 1999, Skënder's mortal remains were transferred to the village cemetery in Negroc/Negrovce.

Sadri (Hasan) Muqolli

(born 7/01/1945, Albanian from Poklek i
Vjetër/Stari Poklek, Glllogoc/Glogovac mu-
nicipality, worker, four children)

Naim (Qazim) Kluna

(born 3/02/1961, Albanian from Poklek i Ri/
Novi Poklek, Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality,
worker, three children, member of KLA)

Naim worked at the wheat mill owned by a local resident Sefer Smajli. He joined the KLA in 1997. Sadri worked at the Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality Civil Registry Office. Because of the Serb attack on 19 September 1998, Sadri, his family and other local residents fled to a forest above the village [**Poklek**]. Once they got there, he and a group of men from the village, including Naim Kluna and some KLA members, separated from the women and children. Serb forces discovered them on **25 September 1998**, late in the evening. Sadri and Niam were killed in the exchange of fire. They were buried two days later in the cemetery in Poklek.

Fadil (Asllan) Krasniqi

(born 8/06/1977, Albanian from Negroc/
Negrovce, Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality,
construction worker, six children, member of
KLA)

The local KLA headquarters was located in Fadil's yard. Fadil was responsible for organizing guard-duty in the village and the distribution of weapons to the surrounding villages. On 20 September 1998, Serb forces attacked the village. Fadil took his family to Qerim Halilaj's in Tërdec/Trdevac, and returned to Negroc/Negrovce. When his family returned to their village ten days later, Fadil's wife Fatmire was informed by a KLA member that Fadil had been killed on **25 September 1998** in **Vuçak/Vučak**, in a surprise attack by Serb forces. He was buried on 30 September 1998 in the cemetery in Negroc/Negrovce. On 5 September 1999, Fadil's mortal remains were transferred by his family members to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Negroc/Negrovce.

Ilaz (Maliq) Javori

(born 1/05/1962, Albanian from Llazicë/Lozica,
Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, construction
worker, two children, member of KLA)

Skender (Liman) Shala

(born 20/08/1977, Albanian from Vuçak/
Vuçak, Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality, single,
construction worker, member of KLA)

Skender was a construction worker. He joined the KLA in mid-1998 in Negroc/Negrovce. At the beginning, he kept watch near the cemetery in that village, to be transferred later to positions in Llapushnik/Lapušnik. Ilaz lived with his family in Lla-zicë/Lozica. He was a construction worker too. On **26 September 1998**, Skender and Ilaz were killed in clashes with Serb forces in a forest between **Baj-**
