Muhamet (Avdyl) Zeneli

(born 21/09/1975, Albanian from Jabllanicë/Jablanica, Gjakovë/Đakovica municipality, farmer, member of KLA)

Muhamet had been actively engaged in the National Movement for Kosovo Liberation since 1993. At the onset of conflicts, he joined the KLA. He was stationed in his home village of Jabllanicë/Jablanica. When the first attack on the village started on **24 May 1998**, Muhamet had mounted his post at the place called *Shtraza/Štraza [Jabllanicë/Jablanica]*. Serb forces began approaching that place with tanks and infantry. They were firing and Muhamet was hit. After the withdrawal of Serb forces on 28 May 1998, Muhamet's relatives returned to the village and buried him at the Jabllanicë/Jablanica cemetery.

Halit (Asllan) Asllani

(born 18/03/1961, Albanian from Brovinë/Brovina, Gjakovë/Đakovica municipality, economist, member of KLA)

Halit joined the KLA in the spring of 1998. He was seriously wounded in the clashes with Serb forces that took place on **29 May 1998** in the village of **Brovinë/Brovina**. KLA fighters transported him to Nivokaz, but later that day he died of his wounds. He was buried in Nivokaz. After the war, in the summer of 1999, his remains were transferred to his native village of Brovinë/Brovina and re-buried at the local cemetery.

Dragan (Vojislav) Ignjatović

(born 23/03/1972, Serb from Gornji Brestovac, Bojnik municipality, one child, member of VJ)

Dušan (Vojislav) Tasić

(born 15/06/1977, Serb from Požarevac, auto-electrician, member of VJ)

Vojkan (Petar) Matić

(born 21/10/1977, Serb from Trnjan, Aleksinac municipality, electro-technician, member of VJ)

Dragan, Vojkan and Dušan served with the VJ 549th Motorised Brigade. Dragan was a sergeant and Dušan and Vojkan were doing their mandatory military service. They were stationed in the Gjakovë/Đakovica barracks. Before going into the military, Dušan occasionally worked for a private entrepreneur. Vojkan was the only son of his parents and wished to help them run their agricultural pharmacy after finishing military service.

On **29 May 1998**, Dragan, Dušan, Vojkan and three other VJ soldiers went on a reconnaissance mission into the border region in a combat vehicle. They stopped in **Smolicë/Smonica**, to relieve themselves at a WC. At that moment, one of them activated a mine which seriously wounded all the men. Because help took a long time to arrive, Vojkan and Dragan passed away. Dušan died on the way to the Military Medical Academy (VMA), in Belgrade. Vojkan's family received his body the following day and buried him on 31 May 1998 in Trnjan. Dušan was buried on 1 June 1998 in Požarevac, and Dragan in Gornji Brestovac.
