

stepped out of the car to remove the rocks from the road. At that moment, a group of KLA fighters popped up. They captured Nenad and the Catholic Albanian, put masks on their heads and drove them to the local KLA headquarters in **Jabllanicë/Jablanica**. Nenad was battered with baseball bats and other objects. He was so badly injured that he could not walk. The next afternoon [14 June 1998], two KLA members took Nenad away, after which he disappeared without a trace. The Catholic Albanian was released. Nenad's family is still looking for his body. Nenad is listed on the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050025-01.

Dragan (Borislav) Stamenković

(born 3/11/1964, Serb from Čečina, Doljevac municipality, one child, member of MUP RS)

Dragan completed secondary school for commerce. For a short period of time, he worked at the Niš Electronic Industry - El Niš. Then he completed a course for police officers and entered the Ministry of the Interior in November 1992. He worked at Doljevac Secretariat of Internal Affairs – SUP, and lived in Čečina with his wife Dragana, little daughter Jovana, father Borislav and mother Desanka. Dragan was sent to Kosovo on 10 May 1998. In the early morning of 14 June 1998, at 03:20h, he was hit by a sniper bullet while in a trench in the village of **Rakovinë/Rakovina** with his friend Keki. He was buried on 16 June 1998 in Čečina.

Adem (Bajram) Selmani

(born 1/07/1967, Albanian from Tropojë [Albania], member of KLA)

Adem worked for the police department in Tropojë [Albania] between 1994 and 1997. He joined the KLA in April 1998. A group of KLA fighters made preparations for border crossings in Adem's house. On 16 June 1998, Adem and several KLA fighters loaded with weapons were about to cross the Serbian border, when Serb forces ambushed them at **Koshare/Košare**, near *Lugina e Rrases/Popločana dolina*. Adem was killed in exchange of fire.

Bejzat (Zenel) Krasniqi

(born 28/11/1975, Albanian from Negroc/Negrovce, Gillogoc/Glogovac municipality, worker, member of KLA)

Bejzat joined the KLA at the beginning of June 1998. On 12 June 1998, he left with a group of KLA members for Albania for weapon supplies. The group was attacked by Serb forces on 17 June 1998 near **Koshare/Košare**. All men managed to escape except Bejzat, who lost his life. It was only on 14 October 2004 that his family was notified by the Forensic Medicine Institute in Rrahovec/Orahovac that his mortal remains had been positively identified. During the recuperation of his body, his family found out that it had been discovered in the mass grave in Landovicë/Landovica [Prizen municipality]. The Krasniqis buried Bejzat's mortal remains on 25 October 2004 in the cemetery in Negroc/Negrovce.
