

2005 that representatives of the ICRC informed the Osmanajs that Imer's body had been found in late August 2003 and kept in the morgue in Rahovec/Orahovac. On 19 May 2005, the Osmanajs recovered Imer's body and buried him later that day in the village cemetery.

Isa (Peshk) Malaj

(born 1942, Albanian from Peraj, Hasit municipality [Albania])

Halim (Zenun) Bardhoshi

(born 15/05/1947, Albanian from Peraj, Hasit municipality [Albania])

Isa and Halim lived in the village of Peraj, Albania, in the immediate vicinity of the Kosovo-Albania border. At the onset of the conflict in Kosovo, the two men transported weapons for the KLA on horseback. On **9 July 1998**, at 01:00h Isa, Halim and another man brought some weapons to *Livadhët e Gjonit/Donijeve livadë (Gjoni's Meadows)* [**Zhub/Žub**], as had been previously agreed with KLA members, and then made their way back. Before long, Serb forces opened fire on them, killing Isa and Halim on the spot. Both men were buried near the end of July in their native village of Peraj.

Skender (Sali) Kuqi

(born 1954, Albanian from Lutogllavë/Ljutogllava, Pejë/Peć municipality, shop owner)

Before 1993, Skender was a school-teacher in his native village of Lutogllavë/Ljutogllava. He also owned a shop in the village of Zahaq/Zahać. On **11 July 1998**, around 15:00h, two armed men in fatigues [the identity of one of them is known to the HLC] entered his shop while Skender was attending his cousin Qerim Kuqi. They spoke Serbian. They ordered Skender to put his hands in the air and then took him to the garage. Three minutes later they returned.

Skender started his *Mercedes*, one of the attackers got in beside him, while the other got into the vehicle they had come in, and they all drove off in the direction of Klinë/Klina. Qazim never saw Skender again. Skender was detained for several days at the local KLA headquarters in **Jabllanicë/Jablanica**. A doctor who worked at the KLA field hospital in the village of Irzniq/Rznić, received Skender Kuqi at an undetermined day of July 1998. Skender had bruises and a swollen face. He died in that hospital of wounds inflicted. His body was later discovered in a wood near Jabllanicë/Jablanica. On 15 July 1998, Skender's nephews went to the KLA headquarters for Skender's body. After a long quarrel, they managed to obtain the body and buried it at the cemetery in the village of Dubovik. In March 2004, the UNMIK Office on Missing Persons and Forensics exhumed the body for an autopsy, which identified several bone fractures on his body, sustained before as well as after his death.

(born 25/05/1954, Albanian from Strellc i Epërm/Gornji Streoc, Deçan/Deçani municipality, waiter, six children)

Ramadan and his family left their village of Strellc i Epërm/Gornji Streoc and took shelter with some relatives in Lumbardh/Ljumbarda. Ramadan's wife and son drove him on 10 July 1998 to the local KLA headquarters in Gillogjan/Glodane. Ramaj intended to go to Albania to get some weapons for the KLA. Three days later, his family heard on TV that Ramadan had been killed on **12 July 1998** at the Yugoslavia-Albania border crossing in the area controlled by the *Koshare/Košare* border outpost. His wife found out later that Ramadan had been buried in Bajram Curri
