Avdyl (Brahim) Hasani

(born 26/06/1926, Albanian from Smolicë/Smonica, Gjakovë/Đakovica municipality, farmer, eight children, member of KLA)

Avdyl, his sons Rexhë and Haki, and nephew Sejdo all joined the KLA on 2 April 1998, the day a KLA unit was formed in their village [**Smolicë/Smonica**]. Avdyl's duty was to keep guard in the village. On **17 July 1998**, at about 08:00h, Serb forces shelled the village. Avdyl held a position in his yard, behind a wall. Some twenty minutes later, a shell went off near Avdyl, killing him on the spot. His family buried him later that day in a field. After the war, on 20 October 2000, Avdyl's remains were transferred to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Smolicë/Smonica.

Ilmi completed secondary school and lived by agriculture. He took part in establishing the local KLA headquarters in Kotradiq/Kotradić. Nazmi was a senior undergraduate student at Law School in Prishtinë/Priština. He joined the KLA on 6 July 1998. The 19-year-old Nazmi was a freshman at the Faculty of Economics in Prishtinë/Priština when he joined the KLA in July 1998. Nimon joined the KLA at the beginning of 1998. Bashkim joined the KLA, following the murder of the Ahmeti family in Likoshan/Likošane in February 1998 [see record], then Agron in March, and Adem and Nazmi
