

After the war, on 9 August 1999, the bodies of Agim, Xheladin and Besnik were transferred to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Kačanik/Kaçanik. Agim was posthumously promoted to Major-General.

(born 6/05/1959, Serb from Gotovushë/Gotovuša, Shtërpçë/Štrpce municipality, three children, member of MUP RS)

Đorđe worked for the *Ivo Lola Ribar* company in Shtërpçë/Štrpce. In October 1995, he entered the police reserve force in Ferizaj/Uroševac. On the night of **23 September 1998**, Đorđe was on a patrol in **Doganaj/Doganović**, when some KLA members opened fire on them. Đorđe suffered a deadly wound. His family buried him on 25 September 1998 in the cemetery in Gotovushë/Gotovuša.
