

to Grabanicë/Grabanica again to search for the missing men. They encountered some uniformed Albanians, who threatened them with guns, saying that Ivan, Burim and Agron had never come there and ordering the cousins to leave Grabanicë/Grabanica. Three or four days later, three Albanian boys from Përlinë/Prlina drove Burim's cart to the police station in Klinë/Klina, after finding it empty in front of their house. Ivan, Burim and Agron are still unaccounted for. They have been registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050078-01, BLG-802896-01 and YUK-050056-01 respectively.

Uka (Sadik) Redžepi

(born 30/09/1953, Roma from Dollovë/Dolovo, Klinë/Klina municipality, tyre repairman, nine children)

Nasret (Haki) Alijaj

(born 15/04/1975, Roma from Dollovë/Dolovo, Klinë/Klina municipality, two children)

On the morning of **20 May 1998**, Nasret, Uka and Uka's grandson left on their bicycles for the green market in Klinë/Klina. On coming back home, they were stopped between **Grabanicë/Grabanica** and Dollovë/Dolovo by two Albanians in camouflage, carrying automatic rifles. Threatening to kill them, they frisked Uka and Nasret and took away the items they found in their pockets, as well as their bicycles. Then they blindfolded them, tied their hands behind their backs and forced them into a car. Uka's grandson was thrown out of the car shortly after. Nasret's and Uka's subsequent fates still remain unknown. They have been registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050068-01 and YUK-050071-01 respectively.

Isuf (Rexhë) Morina

(born 3/07/1950, Albanian from Grabanicë/Grabanica, Klinë/Klina municipality, worker, six children, member of KLA)

Isuf was a member of the *Shpiti* unit, which operated in his native village of **Grabanicë/Grabanica**. When Serb forces started to shell Grabanicë/Grabanica at about 18:00h on **20 May 1998**, Isuf was in the house of Muzli Sahitaj with a group of fellow combatants. A shell went off in the yard, killing Isuf and leaving the other men wounded. Isuf was buried on 24 May 1998 in the cemetery in Bokshiq/Bokšić. After the war, on 2 October 1999, his remains were transferred to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Grabanicë/Grabanica.

Dalibor (Stojan) Lazarević

(born 20/09/1982, Serb from Krushevë e Madhe/Veliko Kruševo, Klinë/Klina municipality, secondary school student)

Dalibor lived with his mother Dobrila, and his brothers and sisters in the *Naglavke* settlement of **Krushevë e Madhe/Veliko Kruševo**. The eldest child in his family, he was in his first year at a secondary technical school. On **20 May 1998** the KLA attacked Krushevë e Madhe/Veliko Kruševo, and the shooting raged all evening. At around 22:00h, four masked KLA members entered the home of the Lazarević family. They slapped Dalibor's siblings on the face and threw his youngest sister out of her crib. When Dobrila, Dalibor's mother, tried to stop them from taking Dalibor away, they hit her with a rifle butt to the head. When they came near to a railroad crossing, some 50 metres away from the
