Siniša (Vojislav) Blagojević

(born 27/10/1966, Serb from Krajishtë/Krajište, Lipjan/Lipljan municipality, forester)

Siniša worked for the *Srbijašume* Public Company at the *Lipovica* hunting ground in Blinajë/Lipovica. He lived with his wife and two daughters in an apartment on the forest estate. After the KLA broke into and searched their apartment, Siniša and his family moved to Llapllasellë/Laplje Selo [Prishtinë/Priština municipality] in June 1998. On **24 June 1998**, Siniša drove on the company tractor to fetch some pigs from **Blinajë/Lipovica**. His fate has remained unknown ever since. A month later, an Albanian neighbour from Krajishtë/Krajište [his identity is known to the HLC] told Siniša's mother Siniša was well, and that he was digging trenches, mowing grass and feeding pigs. Siniša's disappearance was registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050006-01.

Adem (Rexhep) Krasniqi

(born 16/10/1953, Albanian from Zllakuqan/Zlokućane, Lipjan/Lipljan municipality, miner, six children)

Adem had spent all of his life in Zllakuqan/Zlokućane. On **14 July 1998**, at around

16:00h, Adem, his brother Ruzhdi, cousin Gani and two neighbours left for Leletiq/Laletić to express their condolences to a friend who had lost his brother. As they passed through **Vërshëc/Vrševce**, the KLA checked their identification documents and let them continue. On the way back, they were again stopped by the KLA. This time, Adem was kept, whilst the others were ordered to continue their journey. Adem remains unaccounted for since that day. His disappearance was registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050120-01.

Musli (Ferat) Musliu

(born 13/02/1933, Albanian from Belincë/Belince, Shtime/Štimlje municipality, farmer, four children)

Musli lived in Belincë/Belince with his wife Zarifa, daughter Myrveta and sons Mujo and Giner. His third son, Enver, lived in France. On 8 July 1998, some KLA members took his son Mujo to the KLA headquarters in **Kroimirë/Krajmirovce** [Lipjan/Lipljan municipality] for interrogation. As Mujo failed to return home, Musli went to Kroimirë/Krajmirovce on **17 July 1998** to look for him. His family has never seen him since. Mujo returned home six days later, but in ignorance of his father's fate. The next day, Musli's brother Tahir went to Kroimirë/Krajmirovce to find out what had happened to Musli. Some local residents told him they had seen Musli on 17 July 1998, when he had come looking for his
