

Persons on 21 September 2005 handed over Radovan's mortal remains to the Staletić family. Branislav's mortal remains were recovered by his family on 7 April 2006 at Merdare. Both men were laid to rest in the cemetery in Dragobraće [Kragujevac].

Tahir (Brahim) Krasniqi

(born 1967, Albanian from Lladroviq/Ladrovića, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, farmer, two children)

Tahir originally came from **Lladroviq/Ladrović**. He disappeared on **2 June 1998**. Since then all trace of him has been lost. To this day, the Krasniqi family knows nothing of what happened to him. His disappearance is entered on the ICRC list of missing persons under BLG-802615-01.

Đoko (Milan) Gogić

(born 18/10/1930, Serb from Banjë/Banja, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, farmer, five children)

Đoko lived in **Banjë/Banja** alone. On 6 May 1998, he was visiting his son Milisav in Suharekë/Suva Reka, returning home the next day. On 2 June 1998, Milisav spoke with ICRC staff in Suharekë/Suva Reka on their return from Banjë/Banja. They told him that they had looked for Đoko, but that he had not been at home. Milisav heard later on, from some Albanians from Banjë/Banja, that some KLA members had taken his father away on **20 June 1998**. Đoko's fate remained unknown until October 2006, when the Commission on Missing Persons of the Republic of Serbia informed the Gogićs that Đoko's mortal remains had been positively

identified, after being found in April 2005 in the mass grave in Vulljakë/Volujak [Klinë/Klina municipality]. The UNMIK Office on Missing Persons handed over Đoko's remains to his family members on 13 October 2006 at the Merdare crossing point. Đoko was buried the next day in the Novo groblje (New Cemetery) in Niš.

Radoš (Cvetko) Spasić

(born 31/10/1945, Serb from Kijevë/Kijevo, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, primary school principal, two children)

Radoš was the Principal of the *Laza Lazarević* Primary School in **Kijevë/Kijevo**. From May 1998, KLA members were opening fire on police checkpoints in the village on a daily basis. Radoš took his family to safety in Klinë/Klina. At about 18:00h on **24 June 1998**, Radoš left home with a neighbour in order to feed his animals. Near Radoš's house, KLA members opened fire on them, killing Radoš, although the neighbour managed to get away. Radoš was buried in Kijevë/Kijevo without the presence of his family, because road blocks prevented them from coming to the village.
