Her parents rushed her to the KLA hospital in the village of Gradicë/Gradica [Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality], and from there to the hospital in Prishtinë/Priština, where she succumbed to her wounds on 5 September 1998. Her parents laid her to rest on 7 September 1998 at the cemetery in the village of Pllaqicë/Pločica.

### **Sadri (Ramadan) Gashi**

(born 29/03/1937, Albanian from Vërmicë/Vrmnica, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, farmer, five children)

### **Adem (Isuf) Morina**

(born 4/04/1958, Albanian from Llashkadrenoc/Vlaški Drenovac, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, teacher, four children, member of KLA)

### **Hajriz (Haxhi) Morina**

(born 31/07/1973, Albanian from Llashkadrenoc/Vlaški Drenovac, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, student, member of KLA)

On the morning of **24 August 1998** at about 07:00h, Hajriz, Sadri, Adem and some other residents of Llashkadrenoc/Vlaški Drenovac left for Malishevë/Mališevo to obtain some food supplies on behalf of the *Mother Teresa* humanitarian organisation. In the afternoon, their convoy, with a load of food, was making its way back to the village. At the very entrance to the village [Llashkadrenoc/Vlaški Drenovac], near the place known as *Rrafshi/Ravnica (Flatland)*, Serb forces opened artillery fire at them from the direction of Carallukë/Crni Lug village. Adem and Sadri were killed at the scene and Hajriz was seriously wounded. He climbed down from the tractor and hid in a ditch by the road. Approximately ten minutes later, Hajriz's uncle Veli and cousin Agron Morina took Hajriz to the doctor's in Turjakë/Turjak. Not being able to help him, the doctor told them to take him to nearby Panorc/Ponorac. From there, they were sent to the military hospital in Nishor/Nišor [Suharekë/Suva Reka

municipality]. Hajriz died on the way to the hospital. Hajriz and Adem were buried on 25 August 1998 after midnight, in the *Mzez* neighbourhood graveyard in Llashkadrenoc/Vlaški Drenovac. Sadri was buried the same day in the village of Vërmicë/Vrmnica. After the war, in May 2002, Hajriz's and Adem's mortal remains were transferred to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Malishevë/Mališevo.
