### Ramadan (Isuf) Hoxha

(born 4/08/1957 Albanian from Golluboc/Golubovac, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, construction worker, six children)

Ramadan and his family left Golluboc/Golubovac on **25 September 1998** and took shelter, along with other village residents, at *Livadhet e Malokëv/Gorštačke livade (Highlanders' Meadows)*, inside the wood near the *Hoxha* neighbourhood. In the evening, Ramadan was told by fellow villagers that the menfolk should flee deeper into the wood [**Golluboc/Golubovac**], since Serb forces would be entering the wood. Ramadan thus left with the other men. His family have never seen him since. The next day, 26 September 1998, Selman Morina, the sole survivor of the killing in Mujë Haxhe's yard [see record above], told Ramadan's son Avni that he had seen fire and heard members of the Serb forces shouting in the wood belonging to Ramadan's family located near the *Hoxha* neighbourhood. Avni went to the wood the same day and found Ramadan's burnt body there. He buried him in the wood. After the war, in September 1999, the Hoxhas transferred Ramadan's mortal remains to the Cemetery for War Victims in Pllaqicë/Ploçica.

### Hasan (Beqir) Morina

(born 17/01/1973, Albanian from Llashkadrenoc/Vlaški Drenovac, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, student and merchant, married)

### Ahmet (Alush) Pantina

(born 25/08/1979, Albanian from Gllarevë/Iglarevo, Klinë/Klina municipality, farmer, member of KLA)

### Hysen (Rifat) Pantina

(born 29/03/1980, Albanian from Gllarevë/Iglarevo, Klinë/Klina municipality, secondary school student, member of KLA)

Ahmet and Hysen had been members of the KLA since April 1998. Their families left Gllarevë/Iglarevo when Serb forces entered it in early May, while Ahmet and Hysen took to the nearby forests with their fathers and other fellow combatants.

In early August 1998, Hasan married Shemsije. On 18 September 1998, he accompanied Shemsije to her parents' house in Negroc/Negrovce [Gllagoc/Glogovac municipality], after which he returned to Llashkadrenoc/Vlaški Drenovac. Six days later [**25 September 1998**], he left for Negroc/Negrovce to fetch his wife. As Serb forces were everywhere around, Hasan decided to go through the wood. On the way, he came across a group of refugees en route from Llashkadrenoc/Vlaški Drenovac to Negroc/Negrovce, escorted by Ahmet, Hysen and a few other KLA soldiers. Hasan joined them and they proceeded together. At about 22:00h, while passing the place called *Te Pishat e Llagicës/Lozički borovi (Llagicë Pines)* [**Llagicë/Lozica**], they encountered Serb forces. The Serbs opened fire at the column, killing Hasan, Agim and Hysen, while the others managed to escape. The KLA members recovered Agim's and Hasan's body the next day and buried them in the cemetery of Llashkadrenoc/Vlaški Drenovac. Hysen's body was found four days later, above *Te Pishat e Llagicës/Lozički borovi* and buried the next day in the cemetery in Negroc/Negrovce. After the war, on 2 October 1999, Hysen's body was transferred to the Cemetery for Fallen
