Reshat (Bajram) Qerkinaj

(born 26/09/1970, Albanian from Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica)

Reshat was last seen on **4 August 1998** in **Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica**. He was registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under BLG-802649-01.

Ruzhdi (Kajtaz) Beci

(born 21/08/1970, Albanian from Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica, tradesman, two children, member of KLA)

Ruzhdi was deployed to the KLA local headquarters in the village of Likoc/Likovac [*Drenica* region]. On **26 August 1998**, he was visiting his brother Qamil in **Vaganicë/Vaganica**. Late in the afternoon, Ruzhdi left his brother's home and never came back. No trace has ever been found of him since. Ruzhdi was registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under BLG-802826-01.

Selim (Jashar) Segaqi

(born 11/12/1932, Albanian from Pirq/Pirče, Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica municipality, miner, seven children)

Towards the end of August 1998, the local residents left Pirq/Pirče after Serb forces had surrounded this village. Selim's wife, son, daughter-in-law and grandchildren went to Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica on 28 August 1998, whilst Selim stayed at home. The following day, the son and daughter-in-law returned to the village for Selim, but he again refused to leave the house. On **2 September 1998**, the Segaqi family heard on the news that Serb forces had moved into the village that day and that Selim had been killed in his yard [**Pirq/Pirče**]. Two weeks later, Selim's son managed to get in-

to the village, where some KLA soldiers told him that they had buried Selim in his yard on the evening of 2 September 1998. On 16 September 1998, Selim's son transferred his father's body to the cemetery in Pirq/Pirče.

Tadija (Relja) Radivojević

(born 8/10/1954, Serb from Frasheri i Madh/Svinjare, Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica municipality, driver)

Tadija drove an ambulance vehicle at the *Trepča* Mining Complex in **Stantërg/Stari Trg**. He was killed in the late afternoon of **9 September 1998**, while on stand-by duty at *Trepča* at the hands of a Yugoslav Army reservist from Sento [*Zvečan/Zvečan municipality*]. Tadija and the reservist simultaneously opened doors at the opposite ends of the workers' council premises; the reservist opened fire immediately out of fear killing Tadija instantly. Tadija was buried on 10 September 1998 in the Serbian Orthodox cemetery in Frasheri i Madh/Svinjare.

Marinko (Tomislav) Kandić

(born 2/02/1965, Serb from Kërstoc/Krstovac, Pejë/Peć municipality, two children, member of MUP RS)

Marinko was born in the village of Meteh, [Plav municipality, Montenegro]. From 1991, he served as a police officer at the police station in Klinë/Klina. He was killed on **15 September 1998** at around 16:45h, in **Mazhiq/Mažić**, in the explosion of a land mine placed by the KLA. His family buried him on 17 September 1998 in the cemetery in Vragofc/Vragovac [Pejë/Peć municipality].
