

Izet worked for *Elektro distribucija* [Power Supply Company] in Dečan/Dečane. He lived in Raushiq/Raušić with his family. In April 1998, he fled with his family to Montenegro. Vučić and his family fled from Dubovik to Mount Čakor [Montenegro] in May 1998. On **18 June 1998** Izet and Vučić left for Kosovo in Izet's *Zastava* car. Izet had to report to work and Vučić wanted to check whether his house was still standing. Along the way they met Novica, who was riding his bicycle towards Dubočak/Dubočak. Novica's brother Vesko last saw them alive that day in the *Slavica* restaurant near the cemetery in the *Dardania/Brežanik* borough [Pejë/Peć]. All three men were seen in late June 1998 in the KLA-run prison in **Jabllanicë/Jablanica** [Gjakovë/Đakovica municipality]. Three or four days later, they were taken by some KLA soldiers to an unknown location. Their fate has not been clarified to date. Izet, Vučić and Novica are registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050075-01, YUK-050073-01 and YUK-802835-01 respectively.

Misin (Sali) Berisha

(born 1950, Ashkali from Glogjan/Glodane, Pejë/Peć municipality, farmer, six children)

Sali (Misin) Berisha

(born 1977, Ashkali from Glogjan/Glodane, Pejë/Peć municipality, farmer, single)

Xhevat (Misin) Berisha

(born 1986, Ashkali from Glogjan/Glodane, Pejë/Peć municipality, single)

Misin, Ajmone and their five sons had to move frequently, as they did not have a house or land of their own. In 1995, they were lodged in the premises of the Primary

School in **Glogjan/Glodan**. On an **undetermined date in July 1998**, Misin and his sons Sali and Xhevat left the village on a horse-cart and never came back. DNA testing established that three of the bodies found on 11 September 1998 in the *Liqeni i Radoniqit/Radonjičko jezero (Radoniq Lake)* canal were those of Misin, Sali and Xhevat. A post-mortem examination determined that they had been killed with firearms. Their family were informed about the identification of their mortal remains in late March 2009. The Berishas buried the mortal remains of Misin, Xhevat and Sali Berisha on 16 April 2009 in the cemetery in Beleg [Dečan/Dečani municipality].

Vedat (Riza) Komoni

(born 8/11/1966, Albanian from Pejë/Peć, worker, single)

Vedat lived with his family in the *Dardania III/Brežanik III* borough of Pejë/Peć. His family left their home on **5 July 1998**, the day on which clashes broke out in neighbouring Loxhë/Loda between the Serb police and the KLA [see records]. Vedat and his father Riza remained in the village. Later that day, Vedat went to visit his grandmother, who lived nearby [Pejë/Peć]. That was the last time his father saw him. Four days later, Riza was called by the police to identify Vedat's body, which was held in the house of Jakup Ademi in the same borough. On 12 July 1998, Vedat's parents recovered their son's body, with police permission. They saw that the body had been decapitated, although the head had still been there when Riza identified the body. Vedat was buried later that day in the cemetery in *Dardania III/Brežanik III*.
