Bojan (Mile) Randelović

(born 26/09/1973, Serb from Zaječar, student, member of VJ)

Bojan was a third-year student at the Faculty of Electrical Engineering in Niš. He lived with father Mileta, mother Zlatica and grandmother Rozmirka. In December 1997, he enlisted to serve his mandatory term with the army. After spending some time in the Užice barracks, his unit was transferred on 8 June 1998 to the *Kosovski junaci (Kosovo Heroes)* barracks in Prishtinë/Priština. He telephoned to his parents from Prishtinë/Priština every day. Twice a week, he would go to nearby

Gračanicë/Gračanica to do guard duty. On **8 December 1998**, he telephoned his parents and told them he was going to his guard post for the last time [he was about to complete his military service in mid-December]. That evening, Bojan's family was informed that Bojan had lost his life at his guard post. The family received his body the next day and saw that Bojan had been hit with a bullet to the forehead. However, the official certificate issued by the Yugoslav Army stated that Bojan had committed suicide by shooting himself in the mouth. Bojan was buried by his family members on 10 December 1998 in the Zaječar town cemetery.
