Hazir (Hysen) Selimaj

(born 28/08/1954, Albanian from Grejkoc/Grejkovce, Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality, farmer, three children, member of KLA)

Zenel (Hasan) Curraj

(born 24/06/1973, Albanian from Grejkoc/Grejkovce, Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality, construction worker, two children, member of KLA)

Sabit (Rifat) Lushaj

(born 7/08/1975, Albanian from Grejkoc/Grejkovce, Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality, farmer, married, member of KLA)

Naser (Rizah) Tafaj

(born 1/11/1975, Albanian from Grejkoc/Grejkovce, Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality, builder, one child, member of KLA)

Fadil (Muhamed) Balaj

(born 28/12/1977, Albanian from Korishë/Koriša, Prizren municipality, worker, married, member of KLA)

On 5 August 1998, Zenel, Sabit and Naser set off for Albania with a group of young men from the village in order to buy weapons. Waiting to meet them in Albania were Hazir and another acquaintance from Grejkoc/Grejkovac, who helped them with their purchases. On **17 August 1998**, Hazir, Zenel, Sabit and Naser started out on the return journey to Kosovo with a group of men, among whom was Fadil, who had arrived five days earlier to buy weapons also. At around midnight near the border post in **Goruzhup/Goruzhup** on Mount *Pashtrik/Paštrik*, the group was ambushed by the Yugoslav Army. Zenel, Hazir, Sabit and Fadil were killed instantly in the exchange of fire and from an exploding shell, whilst Naser was seriously injured. He managed to pull out towards Lubizhdë e Hasit/Ljubižda Has, but died at *Liqeni i grave/Žensko jezero (Lady's Lake)*, between the villages of Lubizhdë e Hasit/Ljubižda Has and Goruzhup/Goruzhup. Members of the Yugo-

slav Army took the bodies of Fadil, Zenel, Hazir and Sabit to the morgue in Prizren. On 19 August 1998, their families took possession of their bodies. Zenel, Hazir and Sabit were buried the same day at the cemetery in Grejkoc/Grejkovac. After the war, on 15 September 1999, Fadil's body was removed to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Landovicë/Landovica. On 18 September 1999, the bodies of Zenel, Hazir, Sabit and Naser were taken to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Suharekë/Suva Reka.

Din (Adem) Temaj

(born 18/10/1946, Albanian from Kushnin/Kušnin, Prizren municipality, farmer, six children, member of KLA)

Din joined the KLA in 1998. He was in charge of food and weapon supplies. As he lived on the Albanian border and was familiar with the terrain, he also acted as a guide for KLA soldiers crossing the border. He was last seen alive on **18 August 1998** while crossing Mount *Pashtrik/Paštrik* on a mission. To this day, his family knows nothing of what became of him. On the ICRC list of missing persons, Din's disappearance is listed under BLG-804534-01.

Marijan (Ndreca) Domgjonaj

(born 1/06/1942, Albanian from Gražhdanik/Gražhdanik, Prizren municipality, eight children)

At about 10:30h on **30 August 1998** in **Gražhdanik/Gražhdanik**, four unknown men forced Marijan into a *Volkswagen Golf* with no registration plates and drove off. Ten days later, on 9 September 1998, his body was found buried in Leskovec. He had been killed by a shot to the head.
