

Sylë, Cymë and others had been released, and took him to Sylë's, where Cymë and other people were. Beqir was in a very bad condition. Doctor Mirko Pešić came to see him two times and gave him infusion. He said that Beqir had to go to the hospital but he could not take him there without the permission of the Chief of Police. Beqir died on 7 June 1998 of the consequences of torture. He was buried later that day in the Sylë's yard. In 1999, his family reburied his mortal remains in the Deçan/Deçane cemetery.

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### **Isuf (Camë) Mazrekaj**

(born 26/03/1938, Albanian from Voksh/Vokša, Deçan/Deçani municipality, farmer, seven children, member of KLA)

Isuf stayed in **Voksh/Vokša** with his son Isni and cousin Mus Zekaj from Carrabreg/Crnobreg, after the Serb attack of 1 June 1998. On **7 June 1998**, at around 08:00h, Isuf left the house, telling Mus that he would go to the forest where there were KLA members. As he did not come back, his son Isni went to the forest to look for him. The KLA members he found there told him that Isuf had not been with them. No trace of Isuf has been found since that day. His disappearance is registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under ICRC Nr BLG-801404-01.

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### **Elaz (Fazli) Dautaj**

(born 1922, Albanian from Carrabreg i Epërm/Gornji Crnobreg, Deçan/Deçani municipality, farmer)

Elaz lived with his nephew Musa and his family. He had never married. Musa left the village with his family on 2 June 1998, and Elaz stayed behind. Musa came to **Carrabreg i Epërm/Gornji Crnobreg** on **9 June 1998** to bring Elaz some food for

and begged him to come with him but Elaz refused to do so. When Serb forces entered the village on 11 June 1998, Musa could no longer visit the old man. In September 1998, when the situation calmed down a bit, Musa returned to the village with his family and found his uncle's body buried in the yard. On a tree besides the grave, he found a bloodstained knife. His cousins helped him move Elaz's body to the garden next to the house. In May 2000 Elaz's family members re-buried his mortal remains in the local cemetery.

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### **Jakup (Abaz) Dautaj**

(born 15/02/1941, Albanian from Carrabreg i Epërm/Gornji Crnobreg, Deçan/Deçani municipality, farmer, five children)

Jakup had three sons and two daughters. His son Hamdi was killed on 3 June 1998, at the entrance of Prilep [see record]. From that moment on, Jakup went to Prilep every day, in an attempt to find his son's body. On **12 June 1998**, he set out with his son Bedri. At around 18:00h, they were entering **Prilep**, when Serb forces opened fire on them, hitting Jakup twice. His son rushed him to the KLA hospital in Irzniq/Rznić, where he was administered first aid. In late July, Jakup's family took Jakup to the village of Broliq/Brolić [Pejë/ Peć municipality], where KLA doctors took care of him. However, he developed sepsis and died on 12 September 1998. His family buried him at the cemetery in Broliq/Brolić, where he rests to this day.

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### **Kujtim (Muharrem) Gjukaj**

(born 9/07/1978, Albanian from Strelc i Ulët/Donji Streoc, Deçan/Deçani municipality, member of KLA)

Kujtim, his brother Avni and father Muharrem joined the KLA in early March 1998. On **13 June 1998**, Kujtim was wounded in clashes with Serb forces at **Isniq/Istinić**. His father and brother took him
