

hough seriously wounded, withdrew with the rest of the group, only to die shortly afterwards. One of his comrades took his body to the village of Vllanë in Albania and buried him there. Two days later, Yugoslav Army border guards took the bodies of Latif, Rrustem and Shpejtim to the morgue in Prizren. Shpejtim's parents were informed of his death, and on 13 October 1998, they took the bodies of Shpejtim and Latif from the morgue, but Rrustem they did not know. They buried their son Shpejtim the same day in Suharekë/Suva Reka, and then took Latif's body to his family in Dobërdelan/Dobrodeljane, where he too was buried the same day. Next day, Rrustem's family took his body from the morgue and laid him to rest the same day at the cemetery in Dobërdelan/Dobrodeljane. When the war was over, in 2000, Hasan's mortal remains were removed to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in the village of Kleçkë/Klečka [Lipjan/Lipljan municipality].

On 10 October 1998, the cousins Enver and Kujtim set out from Pagarushë/Pagaruša with Enver's cousin Sami to obtain weapons in Albania. They stayed first in Krushë e Madhe/Velika Kruša, arriving on 13 October 1998 in Gjonaj/Donaj at the house of the local commander, Hamez Miftari. On **15 October 1998** they crossed the border with some other members of the KLA, among whom was Hamëz Ukaj. Near the borderpost in **Goruzhup/Goruzup** on Mount *Pashtrik/Paštrik*, Enver, Kujtim, Sami and Hamëz walked into a minefield. The first three were killed instantly, whilst Hamëz was wounded, but died soon after. On 18 October 1998 his comrades-in-arms managed to recover his body and bury him at the cemetery in the village of Vllanë [Albania]. Two days later, Yugoslav Army border guards recovered the bodies of Enver, Kujtim and Sami and took them to the hospital in Prizren. The families took custody of the bodies on 26 October 1998. Enver and Kujtim were buried on the same day at the cemetery in Shkozë/Milanović and Sami at the cemetery in Pagarushë/Pagaruša. After the war, on 18 October 1999, Hamëz's mortal remains were removed by his family to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Landovicë/Landovica.
