Milica's fate remains unknown. Her disappearance was registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050076-01.

### **Darinka (Radovan Vujošević) Kovac**

(born 18/09/1932, Montenegrin woman from Ratiš i Epërm/Gornji Ratiš, Dečan/Dečani municipality)

### **Vukosava (Radovan Vujošević) Marković**

(born 9/08/1937, Montenegrin woman from Ratiš i Epërm/Gornji Ratiš, Dečan/Dečani municipality)

The sisters Vukosava and Darinka were last seen alive on **21 April 1998** in **Ratiš i Epërm/Gornji Ratiš**. Their bodies were found on 12 September 1998 in the *Liqeni i Radoniqit/Radonjičko jezero (Radoniq Lake)* canal. Darinka's daughter Vera recognised parts of their clothing. It was established that the two women had been killed by firearms. Vukosava had a metal wire wrapped around her waist. Darinka and Vukosava were buried on 19 September 1998 in a grave near the village of Piskotë/Piskot [Gjakovë/Đakovica municipality]. During 2005, that grave was dug up twice, but Darinka's and Vukosava's bodies were not there.

### **Miloš (Batrić) Radunović**

(born 19/02/1938, Serb from Dashinoc/Dašinovac, Dečan/Dečani municipality, farmer, three children)

### **Slobodan (Mirko) Radošević**

(born 8/10/1934, Serb from Dashinoc/Dašinovac, Dečan/Dečani municipality)

Most of the Serbs, mainly elderly people, who lived in **Dashinoc/Dašinovac**, fled from the village on 21 April 1998. Only Miloš Radunović, Slobodan Radošević and the Marković family stayed behind. Slobodan's son Staniša came to the village on **22 April 1998** intending to take his father with him. He told his father that his mother (Slobodan's wife) had been abducted and that the KLA had set up its posts around the village and that no one could move freely. The father convinced him that he would come to Dečan/Dečane that evening, through the woods. That was the last time Staniša saw his father alive. The next morning, Staniša was visited by Slaviša Marković, who came from Dashinoc/Dašinovac and told him that the previous evening at around 19:00h he had heard shooting from the direction of the Radošević house and that Slobodan had probably been captured or killed. Another Serb told Staniša of having seen KLA soldiers take Miloš Radunović and Slobodan Radošević away in a car towards the village of Pozhare/Požar on 22 April 1998. He could tell that the two men had been beaten. In early September 1998, members of the Serbian Ministry of the Interior, found the bodies of Miloš Radunović and Slobodan Radošević by the road at the entrance of Dashinoc/Dašinovac. Six years later, pathologists of the Institute of Forensic Medicine in Belgrade performed a post-mortem examination of Slobodan's body and established that he was killed by a shot to the
