

a brother who was a police inspector in Rahovec/Orahovac.

On 12 July 1998, Visar became a father for the first time, so he and his father Azem took seven days off. On Friday **17 July 1998**, they came to their place of work with food and drink to celebrate with their workmates. At about 14:30h, they set off back to town. Near the *Jaha Petrol* station they were stopped by KLA soldiers, who took them out of their car and brought them to the farm of a KLA member [whose identity is known to the HLC], and from there to the KLA prison in **Malishevë/Mališevo**. On 26 July 1998, KLA soldiers drove both of them, together with other detained civilians, in a bus towards Prishtinë/Priština. After an hour, the bus broke down and the prisoners were transferred to a lorry. After driving for two or three hours, they arrived at an unidentified Albanian village. The soldiers took out Azem, Visar, the Baljošević family, [Snežana, Krunoslava and the baby], the Lukić family [the wife and daughter of Jovan Lukić] and three Albanians, and put them in a cowshed. Next morning, 27 July 1998, the soldiers drove off with Azem, Visar and the three Albanians. Azem's and Visar's mortal remains were found at the Dragodan cemetery in Prishtinë/Priština. The family laid them to rest on 19 November 2005 in Rahovec/Orahovac.

Srdan (Arsenije) Vitošević

(born 29/11/1972, Serb from Rahovec/Orahovac, administrative officer, one child)

Srdan worked as an administrative officer at the Revenue Administration in **Rahovec/Orahovac**. On Friday [**17 July 1998**], Srdan and his wife were getting ready to leave for the sea. At about 18:30h, Srdan set off for the pharmacy beside the Health

Centre in his *Opel Kadett*, to buy nappies for the baby. He was wearing a light t-shirt, shorts and sandals. He was stopped by KLA soldiers at an unspecified place in town and taken to the *Pojilo*. He was then taken with other Serbs and Roma to the KLA prison in **Malishevë/Mališevo**. He was locked up with his cousin Srećko, Dušan Patrnođić, Aleksandar Stanojević and Jovan Lukić. On the evening of 18 July 1998, KLA members took Srdan and the others in his room out of the prison, as the first group. Until 2006, Srdan's name was on the ICRC list of missing persons, when it was removed and marked »found dead«. The family has not taken his mortal remains to this day, because they believe Srdan is alive.

Agron (Gani) Hamza

(born 14/02/1968, Ashkali from Rahovec/Orahovac, worker, three children)

Agron worked as a messenger in the *18. novembar* company in Rahovec/Orahovac. On Friday [**17 July 1998**], he came home from work at about 14:00h. After lunch, he went with his family to visit his sister Hajrija. At about 17:00h, when they heard the first shots fired in the town, Agron and his family set off home. At the crossroads at the entrance to Agron's neighbourhood [**Rahovec/Orahovac**], they were stopped by four armed men in civilian clothing, speaking Albanian. They immediately began to punch Agron and hit him with the butts of their rifles. They took him with them and ordered the others to return towards town. His mortal remains were found near Glllogoc/Glogovac. He was buried on 15 August 2005 at the Muslim cemetery in Rahovec/Orahovac.
