

Gëzim was first buried in the outskirts of town, and after the war transferred to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Rahovec/Orahovac. Serb police buried Sadik at the cemetery in Prizren. On 26 July 1998, KLA soldiers took Sadik's body to the village cemetery in Kleçkë/Klečka. After the war, in August 2001, his remains were removed to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Kleçkë/Klečka. Agim was identified on 5 December 2007 and buried on 18 December 2007 in the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Kleçkë/Klečka. His mortal remains were found at the Muslim cemetery in Rahovec/Orahovac on 16 June 2007. Faik's mortal remains were identified on 1 April 2005, when they were also buried at the Muslim cemetery in Rahovec/Orahovac. They were found in the *Rimnik* field, near the river. Liman's body has not yet been found and his name is on the ICRC list of missing persons under BLG-804810-01.

### Afrim (Fazli) Krasniqi

(born 5/10/1975, Albanian from Lladroviq/Ladrović, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, student, member of KLA)

Afrim was a second year economics student at Prishtinë/Priština University. In early July 1998, after helping to transport weapons in from Albania, he joined the KLA HQ in Kleçkë/Klečka [Lipjan/Lipljan municipality]. He was killed on **19 July 1998** while fighting Serb police in **Rahovec/Orahovac**. His comrades buried him on 24 July 1998 at the place called *Plepat e Rahovecit/Topole Orahovca (Poplar Trees of Rahovec)*. After the war, on 19 Septem-

ber 2000, his mortal remains were removed to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Kleçkë/Klečka.

### Hamdi (Sadri) Berisha

(born 3/02/1958, Albanian from Carravranë/Crnovrana, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, teacher, four children, member of KLA)

Hamdi was the eldest of twelve brothers and sisters. On completing his studies of Albanian Literature at Priština University, he found work as a teacher in a secondary school in **Rahovec/Orahovac**. He was a member of the local KLA HQ. At first he manned the guard posts, before becoming commander of a small detachment. When KLA units entered Rahovec/Orahovac on Friday 17 July 1998, Hamdi responded to a call from the commander for immediate mobilisation. He left his home armed and his family never saw him alive again. He died in a battle with Serb police at the exit from the town on **19 July 1998**. His body was found on 23 July 1998 by his brother Refki. With the help of Hamdi's comrades, Refki buried him the same day in Carravranë/Crnovrana. After the war, on 10 June 2001, Hamdi's mortal remains were removed to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Malishevë/Mališevo.

### Goran (Milorad) Tiosavljević

(born 17/09/1969, Serb from Baljevac, one child, member of MUP RS)

Goran completed Secondary School for Tourism in Kraljevo, followed by a course for police officers. From 1990, he worked as a traffic officer in the Secretariat of the Interior in Prizren. At about 17:30h on **19 July 1998**, he was killed in clashes with the KLA near the *Jaha Petrol* station, at the entrance to **Rahovec/Orahovac**.
