Dejan (Vladimir) Mihajlović

(born 17/09/1971, Serb from Užice, member of MUP RS)

Dejan finished mechanical school and a police training course. He entered the MUP on 21 September 1991. Before coming to Kosovo, he worked at the border police station at the Belgrade passenger dock on the *Sava* River. He was killed in clashes with KLA members at the checkpoint in **Strellc i Epërm/Gornji Streoc** on **11 July 1998**.

Rexhë (Sadik) Qorraj

(born 27/02/1961, Albanian from Carrabreg i Ulët/Donji Crnobreg, Deçan/Dečani municipality, lawyer, four children, member of KLA)

Arton (Nezir) Qorraj

(born 13/10/1980, Albanian from Carrabreg i Ulët/Donji Crnobreg, Deçan/Dečani municipality, secondary school student, member of KLA)

Rexhë and Arton were cousins. Rexhë joined the KLA on 20 April 1998. Arton was attending the third year of secondary school when he became a KLA soldier. Rexhë was in charge of the logistics. They both died on **13 July 1998** during clashes with Serb forces in **Carrabreg i Ulët/Donji Crnobreg**, near the house of Ibër Demhasaj. Their families buried them the

following day in a field inside the village. In November 2000, their mortal remains were transferred to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Gillogan/Glodane.

Isuf (Hysen) Imeraj

(born 27/02/1931, Albanian from Isniq/Istinić, Deçan/Dečani municipality, school teacher, five children)

Isuf was a retired school teacher. The men who were assigned the duty of protecting the village were staying in his house. Serb forces began to shell the village on **13 July 1998** around 18:00h, from the direction of the Pejë/Peć - Deçan/Dečane main road. Around 20:30h, Isuf and his family left the house and joined the villagers who had taken shelter near the Out-patient Clinic [**Isniq/Istinić**]. Shortly afterwards, shells began falling on that place. One shell went off next to Isuf, leaving him badly wounded. He was first brought into the clinic and then transposed by some KLA members to the KLA field hospital in Irzniq/Rznić. Isuf died on the way to Irzniq/Rznić. He was buried the next day, on 14 July 1998, in the village cemetery in Isniq/Istinić.

Enver (Hasan) Avdimetaj

(born 10/01/1969, Albanian from Strellc i Epërm/Gornji Streoc, Deçan/Dečani municipality, veterinary technician, two children, member of KLA)

Enver joined the KLA on 25 April 1998 and was immediately appointed commander of the local headquarters in **Strellc i Epërm/Gornji Streoc**. He was engaged in bringing weapons from Albania. Enver was killed on **14 July 1998** in clashes with Serb forces in Strellc i Epërm/Gornji Streoc.
