

Municipality Skënderaj/Srbica

Hysen (Nezir) Mangjoll

(born 5/01/1947, Albanian from Mikushnicë/Mikušnica, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, worker, married, eight children)

Hysen lived with his family in Mikushnicë/Mikušnica. He worked for the *Budučnost* roof tile factory in **Skënderaj/Srbica**. On the morning of **22 January 1998**, at about 07:30h, Hysen went to work as usual. His brother Haki and nephew Bujar went with him to town to do some shopping. At the crossroads near the *Jashari* neighbourhood in Prekaz i Poshtëm/Donje Prekaze, Hysen, seeing that he was running late, decided to take a shortcut which passed near the Ammunition factory in which Serb forces were quartered. Five minutes after they had parted, Hysen, Haki and Bujar heard shooting. On returning to the village that evening, Haki and Bujar learned from a neighbour, Hajriz Islami, that Hysen had been killed and that his body had been found by his acquaintance Maliq Muharremi next to the Ammunition factory fence. His relatives brought his body to his home later the same evening. Hysen was buried the next day in the *Mangjoll* neighbourhood cemetery.

Murat (Smajl) Dajaku

(born 3/01/1960, Albanian from Rakinicë/Rakitnica, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, construction worker, four children)

Murat had graduated from a business

school. Before the war, he had worked as a construction worker in Ljubljana [Slovenia] for several years. After returning to Rakinicë/Rakitnica, he worked as a bricklayer and also on his land. On **20 February 1998**, he left for Skënderaj/Srbica to buy some tractor parts. His brother Rustem accompanied him to a crossroads, where he stopped a lorry with Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica license plates, driven by Milan Miletić, who agreed to give him a lift to Skënderaj/Srbica. At around 13:30h, as they drove through **Llaushë/Lauša**, some armed men opened fire on the lorry, wounding Murat in the shoulder. Later in the afternoon, some local residents of Llaushë/Lauša found Murat in their village lying unconscious by the roadside, and transported him to the hospital in Skënderaj/Srbica, and thence to the Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica hospital. The next day Murat succumbed to his injuries. He was buried on 25 February 1998 in the cemetery in Rakinicë/Rakitnica.
