

enë and his family and nephews Hajzer and Murtez went to stay in Halit's house. The women and children gathered in one room of Halit's new house, while the adult men - Zenë, Halit, Hajzer, Murtez and Zenë's son Avduallah - gathered in another room, from where they organised the defence. In the evening, Zenë went to the *Lushtaku* neighbourhood to fetch some ammunition, but could not return to Halit's house because of the battle that was raging in the area. Zenë never saw his family again. All six men were killed later in the evening [5 March 1998], as well as Halit's wife Elhame, Zenë's wife Bahtije and their two younger sons, Bujar and Blerim. Zenë's eldest son Valdet, who hid in the attic of Halit's old house, saw Serb police taking the bodies of his mother, brothers and other victims out of the house on 7 March 1998. They were all buried on 11 March 1998 in the *Jashari* neighbourhood cemetery.
