### Velibor (Miroslav) Stojanović

(born 14/12/1974, Serb from Vranje, member of MUP RS)

Velibor was a member of the intervention unit of the Belgrade Police Department from 1996. In May 1998, his unit was sent to Kosovo. He took leave once to visit home, and then returned to Kosovo. His family last heard from him on 24 July 1998. Two days later, they were informed that Velibor had been killed on **25 July 1998** in **Junik**. Velibor was buried on 27 July 1998 at the Bunoševačko cemetery in Vranje.

### Vežir (Hysen) Ademaj

(born 15/03/1971, Albanian from Sheremet/Šeremet, Gjakovë/Đakovica municipality, worker, member of KLA)

Vežir lived in Sheremet/Šeremet with his parents, his older brother and his family, and the family of another brother who worked in Switzerland. On **25 July 1998**, a little after 07:00h, two KLA fighters came over and asked Vežir to come with them to Junik and help defend this village. Later that day [25 July 1998], Vežir was killed fighting Serb forces in the *Kallavaj* neighbourhood of **Junik**. He was buried later that day in his native village of Sheremet/Šeremet.

### Ramiz (Januz) Gashi

(born 25/02/1971, Albanian from Sverkë/Svrhe, Klinë/Klina municipality, construction worker, member of KLA)

At the beginning of summer 1998, Ramiz went to Albania with his fellow fighters. On **27 July 1998**, his family heard

on Priština Radio-Television news that Ramiz had been killed earlier that day in **Gjocaj/Đocaj**, near the Albanian border. After the war, Ramiz's brother Bajram was told by the director of the *Čabrat* company that Ramiz was buried in the cemetery in Bërkoc/Brekovac [Gjakovë/Đakovica municipality]. On 9 October 2000, his body was exhumed and identified, to be re-buried later that day with other fallen KLA fighters of the Klinë/Klina municipality, in the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Grabanicë/Grabanica.

### Avdyl (Ali) Jasiqi

(born 26/03/1966, Albanian from Jasiq/Jasić, Deçan/Dečani municipality, married, member of KLA)

Avdyl lived with his family in Jasiq/Jasić. At the end of March of 1998 he joined the KLA. Between March and July he fought Serb forces in the area of Junik and Jasiq/Jasić villages. On **28 July 1998**, coming back to base from an action, at the place called *Zhare/Žare* [village of **Gjocaj/Đocaj**] he stepped on a field booby-trapped by Serbs, and died on the spot.

### Musë (Ali) Ganija

(born 25/05/1943, Albanian from Gjocaj/Đocaj, Deçan/Dečani municipality, construction worker, eight children, member of KLA)

Musë joined the KLA on 28 March 1998. He was responsible for standing guard in the *Ganijaj* borough, where he lived. On **28 July 1998**, during clashes between KLA and Serb forces at **Gjocaj/Đocaj**, Musë was at his guard post. One shell landed near him, killing him on the spot. Later that evening, after the Serb forces had withdrawn from the village, he was buried by his family and some KLA members in a meadow near his house. After the war he was declared killed in action.
