

On **29 July 1998**, during the Serb shelling of **Junik** from *Podi i Gështenjave/Dolina kestenova* (Chestnuts Valley), Mehmet was in his yard with his uncle Tafa. A shell landed on a yard wall and ricocheted off it, killing Mehmet on the spot and leaving Tafa injured. Mehmet was buried later that day at the Junik cemetery.

Aleksandar (Lazar) Njagul

(born 5/09/1974, Serb from Pančevo, member of VJ, one child)

Aleksandar lived with his wife Daliborka and their child in Pančevo. From April 1997, he served as a professional soldier with the 72nd Special Brigade of the Yugoslav Army. In early June 1998 he was sent to Kosovo. The last time he phoned home was on 1 August 1998, when he told his wife that he would be coming home the following day. However, the following evening [2 August 1998], his wife was informed by Yugoslav Army officials that Aleksandar had died earlier that day in **Junik**, a couple of minutes after stepping on a hand grenade at 15:20h. Aleksandar was buried on 4 August 1998 at the village cemetery at Dobrica [Alibunar municipality].

Miomir (Radovan) Stojanović

(born 26/12/1955, Serb from Pejë/Peć, two children, member of MUP RS)

Elvis (Slobodan) Šunjević

(born 13/04/1969, Bosnian from Rijeka, member of MUP RS)

Nenad (Vitimir) Belošević

(born 21/09/1974, Serb from Cerkolez/Crkolez, Istog/Istok municipality, member of MUP RS)

Elvis completed secondary school for police officers and joined the Pejë/Peć Police Department in June 1988. Nenad Belošević, who worked with Elvis, underwent

training for special police units. Miomir Stojanović worked at the Pejë/Peć unit of the Belgrade Railway Company. As of May 1981, he was a member of the reserve component of the Serbian Ministry of the Interior. On the morning of **2 August 1998**, Elvis, Nenad and Miomir were at the police checkpoint in the village of **Prilep**. At around 10:00h, the KLA attacked the checkpoint. Elvis was fatally shot and Miomir was wounded. When Nenad went to drag Elvis's body away, he was shot by a sniper in the groin. Nenad bled to death on the way to the hospital. He was buried the following day, 3 August 1998, at the Cerkolez/Crkolez cemetery. Miomir succumbed to his injuries on 26 August 1998, at the Military Medical Academy in Belgrade.

Rexhep (Brahim) Kadrijaj

(born 17/06/1974, Albanian from Rastavicë/Rastavica, Dečan/Dečani municipality, farmer, member of KLA)

Rexhep joined the KLA on 10 April 1998. He went to Albania on several occasions to obtain weapons. On **2 August 1998**, Rexhep was seriously wounded in **Rastavicë/Rastavica**, near the place called *Lugu e Mullinit/Dolina Mlina* (Mill Valley). He was taken to the KLA hospital in Irznić/Rznić, but died from severe injuries several hours later.

Emine (Miftar Berisha)

Dervishaj

(born 27/06/1970, Albanian woman from Irzniq/Rznić, Dečan/Dečani municipality, housewife, two children)

On **2 August 1998**, Serb forces shelled the village of Irzniq/Rznić. At around 15:00h, Emine went out to the yard. A shell landed right next to her, killing her on the spot [Irzniq/Rznić]. Emine was buried later that day in the village cemetery.
