

Elfije (Ruzhdi) Rexhepi

(born 1/02/1998, Albanian girl from Prelloc/Prelovac, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality)

Krenar (Nazmi) Rexhepi

(born 1998, Albanian boy from Vushtrri/Vučitrn)

Krenare (Nazmi) Rexhepi

(born 1998, Albanian girl from Vushtrri/Vučitrn)

On the morning of **23 September 1998**, the brothers Ruzhdi and Nazmi fled Prelloc/Prelovac with their wives and babies and sought shelter in a wood above the village of **Krasmiroc/Krasmirovac**, on Mount **Çiçavicë/Çiçavica**. When they entered the wood, Serb forces started shelling it. At about 11:00h, a shell landed and went off near the Rexhepi family. Ruzhdi's seven-month-old daughter Elfije and Nazmi's two-month-old twins Krenar and Krenare were thrown several metres by the force of the explosion and severely wounded. Elfije died two hours later and was buried the same day in the cemetery in Prelloc/Prelovac. Nazmi took Krenar and Krenare to the hospital in Vushtrri/Vučitrn. They died three days later and were buried on 27 September 1998 in the cemetery in Vushtrri/Vučitrn.

Muharrem (Murat) Misimi

(born 20/05/1935, Albanian from Prekaz i Epërm/Gornje Prekaze, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, worker at the *Trepça* mining complex, eight children, member of KLA)

Xhavit (Haradin) Bislimi

(born 16/06/1956, Albanian from Prekaz i Epërm/Gornje Prekaze, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, construction worker, five children, member of KLA)

Mexhit (Hamit) Bislimi

(born 15/04/1960, Albanian from Prekaz i Epërm/Gornje Prekaze, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, construction worker, six children, member of KLA)

Driton (Shaban) Ibrahim

(born 20/04/1976, Albanian from Prekaz i Epërm/Gornje Prekaze, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, unemployed, single, member of KLA)

Muharrem, Driton and the cousins Mexhit and Xhavit were members of the local KLA headquarters in Prekaz i Epërm/Gornje Prekaze. They kept watch around the village. When members of the Yugoslav Army and Serb police on 22 September 1998 attacked the KLA in Prekaz i Epërm/Gornje Prekaze and surrounding villages, Muharrem, Driton, Mexhit and Xhavit were at their posts. They were last seen on **23 September 1998** during fighting with Serb forces, in a wood near the neighbouring village of **Mikushnicë/Mikušnica**. On 25 September 1998, some village residents found the bodies of Mexhit, Xhavit and Driton in that wood. Six days later, on 1 October 1998, Muharrem's body too was found. All four men were buried later the same day in the cemetery in the village of Prekaz i Epërm/Gornje Prekaze.

Naser (Ahmet) Kodra

(born 14/03/1961, Albanian from Prekaz i Poshtëm/Donje Prekaze, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, university student, two children, member of KLA)

Naser was a student of Albanian Language and Literature at university. On **24 September 1998**, Serb forces mounted an attack on the villages of the Skënderaj/Srbica municipality. The local residents fled into the woods, leaving their village in the hands of the KLA. Naser was killed in a firefight in the wood near **Dashec/Doševac**. Serb soldiers put his body onto a tank and transported it to Skënderaj/Srbica. The body was left lying for 24 hours on the tank, which was parked in front of the Police Station. The next day, they drove the tank with Naser's body on it to Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica. Two weeks later, Naser's family learned from the Council for Human Rights and Freedoms in Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica that Naser had been buried in the Albanian cemetery in Zvečan/Zvečan. Four years later, the forensics of the UNMIK Office on Missing Persons and Forensics exhumed his body.
