

Following identification, Naser's mortal remains were handed over to his family, who buried them in the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Polac/Poljance.

Naim (Kadri) Salihu

(born 20/01/1973, Albanian from Shtuticë/Štutica, Glogoc/Glogovac municipality, unemployed, single, member of KLA)

Naim lived with his family in Shtuticë/Štutica. He was last seen by his family on the morning of **24 September 1998**, while he was leaving the village. Naim was killed later that day in clashes in *Gramnik* wood, near the neighbouring village of **Dashec/Doševac**. His family found his body the next day in the wood and buried him that night in the cemetery in Shtuticë/Štutica. After the war, in October 1999, Naim's body was transferred to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Shtuticë/Štutica.

Milazim (Sinan) Behrami

(born 1922, Albanian from Dashec/Doševac, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, farmer, one child)

Milazim lived with his son Vehbi and Vehbi's family. On the morning of **24 September 1998**, Vehbi took his children to the forest and then, after finding shelter for them, returned to **Dashec/Doševac** for his father, who was ill. On approaching the village, he saw tanks rolling down the road and houses in flame. He crawled into his burning house, but did not manage to get his father out. The next day, Vehbi found Milazim's mortal remains in the charred ruins of their house. He buried them later that day, assisted by some relatives, in the village cemetery.

Daut (Fazli) Avdiu

(born 10/02/1939, Albanian from Klinë e Epërme/Gornja Klina, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, worker, two children)

Daut lived with his wife Tahire, their two sons and their families. In mid-July 1998 Serb forces took up positions on the Glavica Peak, from where they opened fire sporadically at the *Avdiu* neighbourhood. Because of that, Daut and his family moved into the house of Tahire's brother in the village of Lubovec/Ljubovac. Three weeks later they moved into the house of a relative in Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica. Two months later [**24 September 1998**], Daut and Tahire went back to **Klinë e Epërme/Gornja Klina** to fetch some warm clothes and food. Daut was shot dead while picking some vegetables from his garden. Tahire, helped by some relatives, carried his body into the house of their cousin Isuf. Daut was buried the next evening in the village cemetery.

Fidan (Jetullah) Bekaj

(born 24/01/1982, Albanian from Likoc/Likovac, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, secondary school student)

When Serb forces entered Likoc/Likovac on 7 August 1998, Fidan and his extended family left the village. They went on tractors to Baks, where many refugees from other villages were seeking refuge too. From Baks, they fled to Mount **Çiçavicë/Čičavica** on 22 September 1998, and stayed in a field near the village of **Krasmiroc/Krasmirovac**, along with many other refugees who had come there with tractors seeking shelter. On the morning of **24 September 1998**, at about 10:30h, Serb soldiers with painted faces and bandanas surrounded the field. After searching the people taking refuge there and taking their valuables, they ordered them to go towards Krasmi-
