Rizah (Zenë) Berisha

(born 13/06/1934, Albanian from Shtuticë/Štu-
tica, Glogoc/Glogovac municipality, farmer,
three children)

Rizah and his first wife Nurije had two sons,
Xhavit i Hajdin. Nurije died very young and
Rizah married Radmila, with whom he had
a son, Abedin. Rizah, Radmila [who had
changed her name to Raba after her marri-
age], Hajdin and Abedin lived in the family
home in Shtuticë/Štutica, and Xhavit and
his family lived in Germany. The family
lived in poverty. In mid-1998, Hajdin mo-
ved to his wife's home village. On an un-
specified date in **October 1998**, while he
was selling cigarettes on the street in Gll-
ogoc/Glogovac, persons unknown came up
to Abedin and took him to the KLA Staff
HQ in the village of Prelloc/Prelovac, whe-
re they questioned him about his father
and asked if he had weapons in the house.
They also beat him. Two hours later, they
put him into the boot of a car and brought
him home. They then led Rizah from the
house and took him away somewhere. Se-
veral days later, a relative told Abedin that
he had seen Rizah in **Qirez/Ćirez**, escort-
ed by members of the KLA. After the war,
Abedin and Raba were driven out of their
home because of her ethnic origin. Seve-
ral years passed before Abedin reported
his father's disappearance. Rizah's name is
on the ICRC list of missing persons under
BLG-804829-01.

Dragiša (Svetozar) Lukić

(born 1/01/1976, Serb from Dresnik/Drnsnik,
Klinë/Klina municipality, one child, member
of MUP RS)

In 1998 Dragiša became a member of the
Serbian Police Reserve. On 7 **October
1998** at about 15:00h, he was manning the
checkpoint in **Aqarevë/Ovčarevo**, when
KLA members opened fire on the check-
point. Dragiša died instantly.

Zymer (Halim) Goxhuli

(born 10/01/1965, Albanian from Makër-
mal/Makrmalj, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, far-
mer, four children, member of KLA)

Isuf (Hysen) Goxhuli

(born 16/01/1970, Albanian from Makër-
mal/Makrmalj, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, la-
bourer, married)

Isuf lived in the *Goxhuli* neighbourhood
with his father Hysen, mother Shefkije,
wife, three brothers and four sisters. His
cousin Zymer, a KLA member, lived with
his wife and two children in the same ne-
ighbourhood.

Serb forces attacked Makër-
mal/Makrmalj on 10 October 1998. The village re-
sidents fled to Mount *Çiçavicë/Čičavica*,
only to return to their village two days la-
ter. At about 08:00h on **14 October 1998**,
Isuf and Zymer headed for Mount *Mali
i Shkozës/Škoza*, to see if there were any
Serb forces in the area. Shefkije accom-
panied them part of the way. On her way
back home, she heard gunshots from the
direction in which Zymer and Isuf had go-
ne [**Makër-
mal/Makrmalj**]. Since Zymer
and Isuf failed to return home by evening,
Isuf's parents, accompanied by cousins
and fellow villagers, went to the wood to
look for them, but did not find them. The
next day, they found Zymer's body, co-
vered with leaves. They buried him the
same day in *Varrezat e Dervishëve/Der-
višove grobnice (Tomb of the Dervish)* in
Makër-
mal/Makrmalj. Isuf's body was not
found until a year later, on 6 August 1999,
inside a hole in the *Gjinoc/Đinovce* neigh-
