Haxhi (Qazim) Përteshi

(born 16/01/1941, Albanian from Duhël/Dulje, Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality, farmer, 11 children)

On **10 June 1998**, Haxhi was taken away from his home [**Duhël/Dulje**] by a group of masked Albanians, one of whom was a KLA member [the HLC knows his identity]. A few days later, some local residents found Haxhi's body near the house of Haradin Rrafshi, close to the intersection of roads leading to Malishevë/Mališevo, Prishtinë/Priština and Suharekë/Suva Reka. Haxhi was laid to rest on 15 June 1998 in the cemetery of the *Sopa* neighbourhood of the village of Duhël/Dulje.

Ismet (Pljak) Beriša

(born 18/02/1972, Roma from Suharekë/Suva Reka, farmer, two children)

Ismet lived with his family in **Suharekë/Suva Reka**, at 19 Vidovdanska Street. On **12 June 1998**, some KLA members took him out of his house and then away to an unknown location. Seven days later [19 June 1998], his body was found mutilated in the village of Topličan/Topličane, next to the Suharekë/Suva Reka - Prizren road. The body was blindfolded, slashed by multiple cuts and riddled with thirty bullets.

Stojan (Mitar) Milošević

(born 1/08/1952, Serb from Shtërpçë/Štrpce, cook, two children)

Stojan worked as a civilian for the Yugoslav Army. He was a cook. He lived with his wife Dobrila, their son Saša and daughter Nataša near the Outpatients' Clinic in Shtërpçë/Štrpce. On **14 June 1998**, Stojan was travelling in a Yugoslav Army convoy transporting food. When passing through **Dulje/Duhël** at about 13:00h, the KLA opened fire on the convoy. Stojan and two other soldiers were wounded, Stojan seriously. He was transferred to the VMA military hospital in Belgrade, where he died a month later of his injuries [13 July 1998]. He was buried on 15 July 1998 at the cemetery by the Church of St. John in Shtërpçë/Štrpce.

Imer (Ramë) Krasniqi

(born 24/04/1957, Albanian from Carallukë/ Crni Lug, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, brick layer, four children, member of KLA)

Imer joined the KLA in late 1997. He lost his life on **16 June 1998** in the fighting with Serb forces near **Bllacë/Blace**. He was buried the next day in his native village. After the war, on 16 June 2000, Imer's mortal remains were transferred to the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Malishevë/Mališevo.
