Momir (Milenko) Pešić

(born 13/04/1968, Serb from Suharekë/Suva Reka, single, member of MUP RS)

After finishing secondary technical school, Momir completed a police training course. In 1992 he joined the Police Station in Suharekë/Suva Reka. He was seriously wounded on **26 July 1998** in clashes with the KLA on the Duhlë/Dulje - **Bllacë/Blace** road. Police transported him to the Military Medical Academy (VMA) in Belgrade, where he died from his injuries on 1 August 1998.

Flamur (Hazir) Perteshi

(born 19/03/1981, Albanian from Duhël/Dulje, Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality, construction worker, single, member of KLA)

Flamur joined the KLA in July 1998. On **27 July 1998**, he was at his position near the village of **Grejçefc/Grejçevce**. He was wounded by hand grenade shrapnel during a fight with members of Serb forces. His fellow combatants carried him to Bllacë/Blace first, and several days later to Gajrak [Malishevë/Mališevo municipality]. Two weeks later, they transferred him to Islam Bytyqi's house in Semetishte/Semetište, where he succumbed to his injuries on 27 August 1998. He was buried later that day in the cemetery in Semetishte/Semetište. His re-burial took place on 24 August 2000 at the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Kleçkë/Klečka [Lipjan/Lipljan municipality].

Xhemail (Muharrem) Kryeziu

(born 26/07/1963, Albanian from Suharekë/Suva Reka, veterinarian, four children)

On the evening of 8 August 1998 Xhemail was at home [**Suharekë/Suva Reka**], watching a basketball game on TV with his family. After the game was over, gunshots were heard coming from the wine cellar in which members of Serb forces were quartered, celebrating the victory of the basketball team they had been cheering on. After midnight, at about 01:00 [**9 August 1998**] a shot rang out and Xhemail received a sniper bullet in the head. His family buried him on 10 August 1998 in the cemetery in Suharekë/Suva Reka.

Dragan (Radovan) Stojanović

(born 21/11/1966, Serb from Donja Trnava, Prokuplje municipality, two children, member of MUP RS)

Dragan completed a secondary school for mechanics and a police training course. In 1992 he was posted to the Kuršumljia Police Station. He died on **16 August 1998** fighting the KLA in **Bllacë/Blace**. His family buried him on 18 August 1998 in the village of Bulatovac [Prokuplje municipality].
