Haxhi (Mustafë) Tolaj

(born 24/10/1960, Albanian from Prilep, Deçan/Deçani municipality, three children, farmer, member of KLA)

Sadri (Azem) Latifaj

(born 24/04/1964, Albanian from Prilep, Deçan/Deçani, two children, worker, member of KLA)

Edmond (Hysen) Dabiqaj

(born 2/10/1976, Albanian from Prilep, Deçan/Deçani municipality, mechanical technician, member of KLA)

Sadri had been serving his mandatory military term in Pančevo [Serbia] for three months, when he was arrested and sentenced to four months in prison for his political views. After serving the sentence, he was obliged to complete the remainder of his mandatory term. After returning to Kosovo, he studied at a business college, but dropped out because of being so often summoned by the police for so-called informative talks. He worked as a bulldozer operator at the *Vodovod* - public water supply company - in Deçan/Deçane. On 18 April 1998, Sadri joined the KLA.

Haxhi joined the KLA on 18 April 1998 in Prilep KLA headquarters. Even before formally joining the KLA, he had gone several times to Albania to obtain weapons.

Edmond joined the KLA on 20 April 1998 at the Prilep headquarters. He was responsible for obtaining supplies.

On 27 April 1998, Haxhi, Sadri and

Edmond were coming back from Albania with a load of weapons. At the place called *Podi Gëshenjave/Dolina kestenova (Chestnuts Valley)* [**Voksh/Vokša**] they were ambushed by Serb forces. Haxhi, Sadri and Edmond were killed on the spot. Their bodies rest in the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Prilep.

Bilall (Idriz) Mazrekaj

(born 29/10/1972, Albanian from Drenoc/Drenovac, Deçan/Deçani municipality, farmer, one child, member of KLA)

Bilall lived with his family in Drenoc/Drenovac. On 29 April 1998, Bilall went with his mother, brother, brother's wife, uncles and their sons to the village of Prilep to attend the funeral of three young men, members of the KLA [see record above]. On their way back, at the crossroads in **Drenoc/Drenovac** near the Gjakovë/Đakovica - Deçan/Deçane road, they ran into some policemen. Without warning, the policemen shot at Bilall. When he fell to the ground wounded, one of the policemen came up and shot him. When the police left the scene, Bilall's brothers carried his body to the family house. They buried him the following day, 30 April 1998, in the village cemetery.

(born 23/03/1923, Albanian from Deçan/Deçane, farmer, five children)

Bekë (Sylë) Shabanaj

(born 3/06/1930, Albanian from Deçan/Deçane, farmer, two children)

Every day, Hajdar would put his cattle out to pasture near the *Bistrica* River and the Monastery of *Visoki Deçani [Deçan/Deçane]*. Bekë also tended cattle on the same spot.
