

the KLA on 24 March 1998 and went to Albania several times to get weapons. Shortly thereafter, he was appointed commander of the unit operating in Carrabreg i Epërm/Gornji Crnobreg. Sokol was wounded on **9 August 1998** during clashes between KLA and Serb forces in **Carrabreg i Epërm/Gornji Crnobreg**. His KLA comrades rushed him to the KLA field hospital in Irzniq/Rznić where he died later that day. He was buried in the Glllogjan/Glođane public cemetery. On 24 August 1998 he was re-buried in his family graveyard at Glllogjan/Glođane.

Zdravomir (Radoman) Bukilić

(born 22/09/1970, Serb from Kolašin [Montenegro] member of the MUP RS)

Zdravomir, a.k.a. "Mijo", completed the Secondary Electro-technical school in Podgorica. He worked as a waiter in Podgorica for a while. He underwent a training course for police officers in Belgrade and entered Deçan/Dečani police department in 1991. On **9 August 1998**, around 1:30 p.m., Zdravomir was killed in **Prilep**. His family had him buried on 10 August 1998 in the village cemetery in Ljuta, near Kolašin.

Srđan (Radivoje) Drašković

(born 7/11/1967, Serb from Leskovac, two children, member of the MUP RS)

Zoran (Đorđe) Đokić

(born 7/09/1970, Serb from Leskovac, one child, member of MUP RS)

Bojan (Zoran) Kocić a.k.a. 'Alf'

(born 14/01/1975, Serb from Leskovac, single, member of MUP RS)

Srđan, Zoran and Bojan a.k.a. 'Alf' worked at the Leskovac Police Precinct - Srđan and Zoran from 1992, and Bojan from 1993. When the Kosovo conflicts broke out, they were deployed to the 37th detachment of the Special Police Units. They all died on **9 August 1998** in the village of **Prilep**, near the spot called *Kamene kule*. Srđan, Zoran and Bojan were buried on 11 August 1998 - Bojan at the village cemetery in Bogojevac, and Zoran and Srđan in the Svetoiljsko cemetery in Leskovac.

Arben (Tahir) Hajdaraj

(born 3/04/1976, Albanian from Shaptelj/Šaptelj, Deçan/Dečani municipality, member of KLA)

Arben joined the KLA at outbreak of conflicts in Kosovo. He was wounded on **10 August 1998** during clashes with Serb forces in **Glllogjan/Glođane**. KLA members took him to the KLA hospital in Irzniq/Rznić, where he died of wounds received on 11 October 1998. He was buried in the Shaptelj/Šaptelj cemetery.
