Five days later, Mursel's brother Vesel found his brother's body and buried it, with the help of some village residents, near the Buqas' house, where he still rests.

Qazim (Brahim) Kololli

(born 1941, Albanian from Budakovë/
Budakovo, Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality,
farmer, five children)

Qazim left Budakovë/Budakovo with some neighbours on 27 September 1998. They took shelter in a nearby wood. Qazim's wife and daughters had already left and gone to Gjakovë/Đakovica. The next day [28 September 1998], Qazim returned to the village to find his son. In his house he found four members of the Serb forces, who beat him before letting him go. Qazim returned to the wood. Later that day, at about 18:00h, Serb forces opened fire on the place where Qazim and others were hiding. The people scattered in all directions. Qazim was last seen alive running towards the *Kepa* neighbourhood of **Budakovë/Budakovo**. Two days later, his body was found by some locals from nearby villages lying in the wood above the *Buzhala* neighbourhood. He was buried the same day in the village cemetery.

Rexhë (Sali) Kokollari

(born 13/05/1928, Albanian from Budakovë/
Budakovo, Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality,
farmer, six children)

Rexhë and his family left **Budakovë/Budakovo** on 27 September 1998 and took to a wood near *Maja e Ahishtes/Bukvin Vrh* (*Beech Tree Peak*), where residents of other villages had also taken shelter. Two days later [29 September 1998] Serb forces started shelling *Maja e Ahishtes/Bukvin Vrh*. The people started fleeing in panic. When the shelling stopped, Rexhë's family gathered together, but Rexhë was not among them. Two days later [30 September 1998], KLA members informed Rexhë's son Milaim that they had found Rexhë's body in a meadow above the Kokollaris' house. Later that day, Milaim buried his father, with the help of some fellow villagers, in the village cemetery. After the war, in June 2000, international forensics exhumed Rexhë's mortal remains and sent them to the Forensic Medicine Institute in Rahovec/Orahovac for an autopsy. In August 2000, the Kokollaris reinterred Rexhë in the cemetery in Budakovë/Budakovo.

Zymer kept watch in front of the KLA field hospital in the *Buzhala* neighbourhood and Murat was at the in the *Kepa* neighbourhood position, when Serb forces entered Budakovë/Budakovo on **29 September 1998** in the afternoon.
