

to the hospital in Pejë/Peć, and then to Prishtinë/Priština, where he underwent multiple surgeries. From Prishtinë/Priština, he was transferred to Novi Sad for further treatment. He died in Novi Sad on 15 March 1999. He was buried on 17 March 1999 in the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants in Gjakovë/Đakovica.

Zenun (Mun) Mataj

(born 25/08/1975, Albanian from Baballoq/Babaloc, Deçan/Deçani municipality, worker, member of KLA)

Nexhat (Adem) Humaj

(born 20/09/1980, Albanian from Baballoq/Babaloc, Deçan/Deçani municipality, worker, member of KLA)

Owing to the death of his father, Zenun dropped out of school and went abroad to work and provide for his mother and six siblings. On 20 April 1998, he returned to Kosovo via Albania and immediately joined the KLA. On 21 April 1998 Nexhat Humaj also joined the KLA in Baballoq/Babaloc.

On **11 August 1998**, Nexhat was killed and Zenun was seriously wounded in clashes between KLA and Serb forces in **Baballoq/Babaloc**. Zenun was taken by his fellow combatants to the KLA hospital in Pagarushë/Pagaruša. Two weeks later, on 25 August 1998, Zenun succumbed to his wounds. Both Nexhat and Zenun rest in the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants at Baballoq/Babaloc.

Halil (Zymer) Sejfiqaj

(born 10/07/1933, Albanian from Glogjan/Glodane, Deçan/Deçani municipality, farmer, five children, member of KLA)

Artan (Isa) Hasanaj

(born 2/06/1976, Albanian from Rakoc, Gjakovë/Đakovica municipality, member of KLA)

Naim (Metë) Nimanaj

(born 6/05/1979, Albanian from Glogjan/Glodane, Deçan/Deçani municipality, member of KLA)

Before 1998, Artan lived with his parents in Switzerland, where they fled to because of continuous troubles with Serb authorities. On 14 April 1998, Artan went to the military base *Golem* near Durrës/Drač, Albania, where he enlisted in the KLA. He was appointed commander of the artillery unit of the *Dukagjin/Dukadini* headquarters. Naim joined the KLA on 24 March 1998; he went to Albania for weapon supplies on two occasions. Halil's family fled Glogjan/Glodane after 24 March 1998, and Halil stayed to defend the village.

All three men were killed on **11 August 1998**, during clashes between the KLA and Serb forces in the centre of **Glogjan/Glodane**. They were all buried initially in the village cemetery to be re-buried after the war in the Cemetery for Fallen Combatants at Glogjan/Glodane.

Antun Željko (Petar) Martinović

(born 24/05/1967, Serb from Prizren, two children, member of VJ)

Antun Željko, born in Vukovar, lived with his family in Đerdapska Street in Prizren. He completed Ground Forces Military Academy. Holding a rank of a captain, he was the commander of the tank company within the 549th Motorised Brigade. Antun Željko was killed on **11 August 1998** around 16:00h in **Glogjan/Glodane** when his tank was hit by a missile.
