

When Serb forces reached the woods on **23 September 1998**, Vesel went with Beqir, a man from Dobroshec/Dobroševac [Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality], to the edge of the woods, to see what was happening in the area. The Serb forces were within 50 metres of them and fired immediately. Vesel was fatally wounded, whilst Beqir managed to escape. Two days later, on 25 September 1998, Vesel's father and some soldiers of the KLA took his body to the Likoshan/Likošane village cemetery and buried him [Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality].

On 19 September 1998, the command of the Yugoslav Army's Priština Corps ordered the 125th Motorised Brigade to support Ministry of the Interior forces in dispersing KLA units in the broad sector of the Mount *Çiçavicë/Čičavica*, including the village of Duboc/Dubovac. On 20 September 1998, the inhabitants of Galicë/Galica left the village on tractors and horse-drawn carts. They arrived in a column in Krasimiroc/Krasmirovac [Skënderaj/Srbica municipality], and then went on to Kozhicë/Kožica [Skënderaj/Srbica municipality]. Serb forces attacked this village on 22 September 1998. The men from Galicë/Galica, including Bajram Sahiti, Shshivar Ademi, his son Fatmir, relative Agim and nephews Burim and Gani, Hetem and his son Bujar, Nazmi, Bexhet and Nexhat Halili, Arsim Brahimi from Oshlan/Ošljane and Sejdi Kabashi from Polac/Poljan-
ce escaped to the woods before the entry of the Serb forces [**23 September 1998**]. The Serb forces kept the women, children and old people for several hours in a meadow and then allowed them to return to their homes. After the withdrawal of the Serb forces on 24 September 1998, people from **Duboc/Dubovac** found the bodies of
