

of his brother Faik. Because of an attack by Serb forces on the village on 20 September 1998, the entire family fled to the village of Dërvare/Drvare, where they were taken in by Fehmi Imeri. Four days later, on **24 September 1998**, Serb forces reached that village too. The family moved to the other end of the village, where they were safer, and Refki decided to go to his cousin Emina's in Vushtrri/Vučitrn. He took leave of his family and set off on foot. His brother Faik stood watching him go, until he got as far as the bridge in neighbouring **Pestovë/Pestovo**, where there were Serb forces. He never saw him again. After a few days, their cousin Emina called to say Refik had not arrived at her house. His fate has remained unclear to this day. On the ICRC list of missing persons, his disappearance is listed under BLG-804545-01.

Xajë (Sahit) Jashari

(born 19/05/1955, Albanian from Stroc/Strovce, Vushtrri/Vučitrn municipality, reporter, five children, member of KLA)

Having completed his studies in education, Xajë worked as a sports reporter for the Kosovo Albanian daily *Rilindja (Revival)*. He was president of the *Besa* sports club in his village [Stroc/Strovce]. He worked on the teleprinter for Radio Television Priština until 1991, when the Serb authorities sacked him, along with other Albanians. He lived with his wife Ajmane, their five children, his mother Sofie and brother Agush. He joined the KLA in April 1998 and was deputy-commander of a unit. In September 1998, the entire family fled to his brother Nexhat's in Mitrovicë/Kosovska Mitrovica, but Xajë stayed in Stroc/Strovce. He was killed on **27 October 1998** while reconnoitring the terrain near the village **Stroc/Strovce**. He was buried on 28 October 1998 at the cemetery in Stroc/Strovce, where he lies to this day.

Sanije (Meho Glavašavić)

Dubovci

(born 1942, Bosnian woman from Vushtrri/Vučitrn, housewife, six children)

Afrim (Mehmet) Dubovci

(born 14/01/1968, Albanian from Vushtrri/Vučitrn, single, unemployed)

Rrahim (Mehmet) Dubovci

(born 17/10/1973, Albanian from Vushtrri/Vučitrn, single, unemployed)

Florim (Mehmet) Dubovci

(born 1/04/1975, Albanian from Vushtrri/Vučitrn, single, unemployed)

Sefedin (Mehmet) Dubovci

(born 7/09/1977, Albanian from Vushtrri/Vučitrn, single, unemployed)

Xheladin (Brahim) Dubovci

(born 7/01/1945, Albanian from Vushtrri/Vučitrn, worker, two children)

The widowed Sanije lived with her sons Afrim, Rrahim, Florim and Sefedin, and Xheladin, the son of her brother-in-law, his wife Sofije and their sons Fitim and Ylber, in the village of Çikatovë e Vjetër/Staro Çikatovo [Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality]. After Sofije's murder in September 1998 [see record], the Dubovci family moved to **Vushtrri/Vučitrn**. Sanije's son Liman, who lived in Germany, kept in regular contact with them up to **1 November 1998**. In mid-November 1998, Fitim and Ylber arrived at the house of their aunt Bahtije, Sanije's daughter, in Gradicë/Gradica [Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality]. The boys were in a state of shock and when questioned as to what had happened, would only say they did not know. The fate of the other members of the Dubovci family has remained unexplained. Their names have been on the ICRC list of missing persons, Xheladin's under BLG-804771-1, Afrim's under BLG-804770-01, Florim's under BLG-804770-02, Sanije's under BLG-804770-03, Rrahim's under BLG-804770-04 and Sefedin's under BLG-804770-05.
