### Zoran (Miroslav) Ađančić

(born 10/12/1968, Serb from Milosheve/Miloševo, Obiliq/Obilić municipality, crane operator, two children)

Filip, Dragan and Zoran worked at the *Dobro selo* opencast mine. On the morning of **22 June 1998**, they left in their assigned cross-country *Uaz* vehicle for the *Belačevac* opencast mine, to fetch some straps, oil and other material they needed, and to finish some other errands. They were accompanied by their two Albanian co-workers, Safedin Sylja and Fehmi Salihu. On arriving in **Graboc i Ulët/Donji Grabovac**, three armed KLA soldiers stopped them near the bridge over the River *Drenica*, checked their identity documents and frisked them. Then they sent the two Albanians away and took Zoran, Dragan and Filip with them in the *Uaz*, after which the three men disappeared without trace. Zoran, Filip and Dragan are listed on the ICRC list of missing persons under BLG-803504-01, YUK-050003-01 and YUK-050004-01.

On **22 June 1998** Pero Ađančić set off to work Raskovë/Raskovo as usual, in his *Yugo* 55, licence plates PR-874-57. His uncle Dušan accompanied him. Mirko Buha was the manager of the *Belačevac* open-cast mine electrical workshop. He left Prishtinë/Priština at 06:30h in his *Lada Niva*, to go to work.
