### **Goran (Rajko) Radojičić**

(born 1/05/1968, Serb from Pančevo, one child, member of MUP RS)

### **Miroslav (Dragutin) Vujković**

(born 10/01/1971, Serb from Pančevo, one child, member of MUP RS)

Goran and Miroslav had worked for the Pančevo Police Department from 1 May 1993. At the beginning of 1998 they were both deployed to the Glogoc/Glogovac Municipal Police Department in Kosovo. On **28 February 1998**, around 11:30h, they were patrolling the area near the village of Likoshan/Likošane, after being called to help their fellow officers whose vehicle had been shot at by the KLA while driving through Likoshan/Likošane. Meanwhile, the Prishtinë/Priština Police Department had engaged a large number of members of the Special Anti-terrorist Unit, who arrived at the Likoshan/Likošane area in a helicopter. As Goran and Miroslav drove in their *Lada Niva* through the *Gjeli* neighborhood [**Likoshan/Likošane**], someone opened fire on them. In the gun battle that followed, both men were killed. Goran and Miroslav were buried on 3 March 1998 in the New Cemetery in Pančevo.

### **Radojica (Dragutin) Ivanović**

(born 29/11/1969, Serb from Prishtinë/Priština, three children, member of MUP RS)

### **Milan (Bogoljub) Jovanović**

(born 11/07/1971, Serb from Lazarevac, member of MUP RS)

Radojica lived with his wife Ljiljana and their children Milijana, Konstantin and Milutin in the *Bregu i Diellit/Sunčani breg* (*The Sunny Hill*) neighbourhood of Prishtinë/Priština. Milan was born in the village of Boljevići, near Bratunac [BiH]. He joined the Serbian Ministry of the Interior in 1992. Both Radojica and Milan were members of the Special Anti-terrorist Unit from Prishtinë/Priština. They died on **28 February 1998**, some time after 15:00h, in **Qirez/Ćirez**. As they were approaching the house of the Sejdiu family, somebody had opened fire at them from a barn. Radojica was buried on 1 March 1998 in the cemetery in Prishtinë/Priština; Milan was buried on 2 March 1998 in Lazarevac.

### **Rexhep (Ajet) Rexhepi**

(born 10/09/1935, Albanian from Qirez/Ćirez, Skënderaj/Srbica municipality, construction worker, one child, member of KLA)

As far back as 1981, Rexhep had participated in the demonstrations against the Serbian regime. On **28 February 1998**, after 12:00h, he was severely wounded in clashes with Serbian police next to Bajram Gjeli's house in **Likoshan/Likošane**. His fellow combatants, Xheme Kodra and Zeqir Rexhepi, brought him inside Ahmet Ahmeti's house, where he immediately succumbed to his wounds. Xheme and Zeqir hid his body in the basement. The following day, after the Serbian police had left the village, Rexhep's family members brought his body into his house in Qirez/Ćirez. Rexhep was buried on 3 March 1998 in the cemetery in Likoshan/Likošane, along with other persons who were killed in the 28 February 1998 clashes in Likoshan/Likošane and Qirez/Ćirez.
