

brother Slobodan. When the train stopped at **Bajicë/Banjica**, three KLA members got on. They approached Ivan, calling out his full name, and then took him off the train. They hit him with a rifle butt to the head, forced him into a jeep and drove off towards a forest. Ivan's family was told two different stories about what had happened to him. According to one story, Ivan was killed along with Žarko Spasić [see record] in the KLA camp in Likoc/Likovac [Gllgoc/Glogovac municipality]. According to the second version, he had been detained at the KLA camp in Mushtishte/Mušutište [Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality], and after the arrival of KFOR, transferred to Tropojë [Albania], with a group of 120 Serbs. His family is still looking for his body. Ivan's disappearance has been registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050009-01.

### Ajet (Kamer) Gashi

(born 22/03/1954, Albanian from Bubavec/Bobovac, Malishevë/Mališevo municipality, pensioner, seven children)

Ajet worked as a police officer in Pejë/Peć, Klinë/Klina and Malishevë/Mališevo until 1990. After retirement, he engaged in farming in his home village of Bubavec/Bobovac. On the morning of **24 May 1998**, Ajet left for Malishevë/Mališevo. He said to his wife Sabrija that some men, whom he did not know, wanted to have a word with him. He never came back. His mother looked for him in the KLA prisons in Likoc/Likovac and Malishevë/Mališevo, but the KLA soldiers told her he was not there. In fact, Ajet Gashi had been detained at the KLA-run camp in **Lapushnik/Lapušnik**, on suspicion of collaborating with Serb forces in Lipjan/Lipljan. On 12 June 1998, his family heard on the VOA news and other media that Ajet's body had been

found on the road between the villages of Magurë/Magura and Lalletiq/Laletić [Lipjan/Lipljan municipality]. His hand was broken and he had visible wounds to the stomach. Ajet was buried by his family in the Bubavec/Bobovac cemetery. According to forensic examinations performed by the forensics of the UNMIK Office on Missing Persons and Forensics in 2004, Ajet Gashi died as a result of multiple gunshot wounds in the head and body.

### Skender (Mehmet) Fejzullahu

(born 1/02/1972, Albanian from Zabel i Ulët/Donji Zabelj, Gllgoc/Glogovac municipality, metal mechanic)

Skender lived with his brothers Rahim, Rahman and Enver and their families in Zabel i Ulët/Donji Zabelj. They left the village on **29 May 1998**, after Serb forces entered Zabel i Ulët/Donji Zabelj, driving the villagers out. All of the villagers headed for Vasilevë/Vasiljevo. While he was passing by village fields [**Zabel i Ulët/Donji Zabelj**], Skender was seriously wounded by sniper fire. His relatives took him to the neighbouring village of Korrotić e Poshtme/Donja Koretica, into the house of Xhemal Rexhepi, and then to the KLA field hospital in Likoc/Likovac [Skënderaj/Srbica municipality]. A month later, on 27 June 1998, Skender succumbed to his injuries. He was buried the next day in the cemetery of his native village of Zabel i Ulët/Donji Zabelj.

### Sami (Firiz) Bogiqi

(born 9/08/1961, Albanian from Vukocv/Vukovce, Gllgoc/Glogovac municipality, four children, member of KLA)
