

camp in **Llapushnik/Lapušnik**. The ICTY established that Jevta Petković was executed while in the Llapushnik/Lapušnik camp. Jevta's and Zvonko's mortal remains were discovered on 28 May 2003 in the village of Rancë/Rance [Shtime/Štimlje municipality], in a secondary grave holding another, unidentified body. Jevta's and Zvonko's families collected their bodies on 10 December 2004 at Merdare and had them buried on 11 December 2004 in Mladenovac cemetery.

Željko was a refugee from Ogulin [Croatia]. He and his family were lodged at the Refugee Reception Centre in Suharekë/Suva Reka. He went missing on **24 June 1998**, while driving back to Suharekë/Suva Reka from Prishtinë/Priština. His personal documents were found in the KLA prison camp in **Llapushnik/Lapušnik**. His family is still searching for his body. His disappearance is registered in the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050014-01.

Živorad (Jeremija) Krstić

(born 7/11/1930, Serb from Prishtinë/Priština, pensioner, three children)

Srboljub (Nikola) Miladinović

(born 14/10/1967, Serb from Rečan/Rečane,

Suharekë/Suva Reka municipality, two children, member of MUP RS)

Živorad was born in the village of Mushnikovë/Mušnikovo [Prizren municipality] and lived in Prishtinë/Priština, at Aktaš 1 Street. He suffered from a severe form of diabetes and had to take insulin regularly. For several years after finishing secondary education, Srboljub worked in private business and then finished a police training course and entered the Police Department in Shtime/Štimlje. At the beginning of the war, Srboljub was not working, as he was suspended at the time.

On the morning of **25 June 1998**, Živorad and Srboljub left Prizren for Prishtinë/Priština on a *Mamuša turs* bus. Živorad was coming back from a memorial service conducted for his brother, and Srboljub was going to visit his in-laws. At around 11:30h, the KLA stopped the bus between Carralevë/Crnoljevo and Duhël/Dulje and made Živorad and Srboljub get off the bus. Srboljub attempted to escape and the KLA soldiers shot him in the legs. After that, they took both men to an unknown location. Srboljub and Živorad were later seen by Vojko Bakrač in the KLA detention camp in **Llapushnik/Lapušnik**. Their families are still looking for their bodies. Živorad and Srboljub are listed on the ICRC list of missing persons under YUK-050028-01 and YUK-050027-01 respectively.
