

*Serbian police shot dead Thursday afternoon a 54-year-old Albanian, Ali Dibrani, in Glogoc, 35 km west of Prishtina, newsletter, KIC, 10.07.1998, HLC-29358.*

### **Idriz (Selman) Obrija**

(born 1937, Albanian from Komaran/Komorane, Glogoc/Glogovac municipality, farmer, seven children)

Clashes between Serb forces and the KLA made Idriz leave Komaran/Komorane with his family on 5 July 1998 and seek shelter at his cousin Elmi Gare's, in Kizharekë/Kišna Reka. In the early morning of **12 July 1998**, Idriz returned to his village with his wife Halime, sons Agim, Selman, Florim and Bekim and grandsons Shpejtim and Shpresim, to fetch some food and clothing. By evening, they were on their way back to Kizharekë/Kišna Reka. Agim was driving, with Idriz in the front seat holding Shpejtim on his lap. Around 20:30h, near the place called *Kroni/Izvor* [**Komaran/Komorane**], they were pulled over by KLA members Gani Gashi and Xhemsir Nishori. Agim greeted the soldiers. Gani pointed his rifle at him, asking who was in the car and where they were going. Agim answered, and Gani sent Xhemsir to ask their commander whether he should let them go or not. Once Xhemsir had left, Gani told Agim that he had been waiting for a long time to have all of them together [the entire family]. Then he went behind the car, cursing Agim and his family, and shot at the passengers through the rear window. Idriz was hit in the chest, and Halime and little Shpejtima were wounded. Idriz died a few moments later. The Obrijas buried Idriz in the cemetery in Kizharekë/Kišna Reka. In March 2009 Gani Gashi was sentenced to 17 years of imprisonment by the District Court of Prishtinë/Priština trial panel presided over by the EULEX Judge Tron Gundersen. The judgement is non-appealable.

### **Agim (Bajram) Ademi**

(born 23/07/1959, Albanian from Godanc i Poshtëm/Donje Godance, Shtime/Štimlje municipality, one child)

Agim lived with his wife, child and father. Being a member of the reserve contingent of the Police Department in Ferizaj/Uroševac, he was given a uniform and a weapon before the war. His family owned a passenger transportation company operating the bus line between Godanc/Godance and Shtime/Štimlje. On 27 June 1998, at around 02:00h, a group of some 10 KLA members wearing masks came to their house. They asked Agim to give them his gun and automatic rifle and then took him away, saying they would bring him back within 45 minutes. Agim Ademi was detained at the KLA prison camp in **Llapushnik/Lapušnik** until sometime before **15 July 1998**, when a KLA member [nickname stated in the transcripts from the trial] took him outside. That was the last night Agim was seen alive. On 18 July 1998, the protected witness L04 [in the case of *Fatmir Limaj and others*] and two other prisoners were taken outside the camp to bury Agim along with two other murdered prisoners, in a location unknown to them. The protected witness L04 saw a gunshot injury on Agim's body. Agim's family is still looking for his mortal remains. He has been registered on the ICRC list of missing persons under BLG-804690-01.

Miroslav lived with his father Milorad and sister Mirjana in Lačarak. He was conscripted in December 1997 and assigned to the *Slatina* Garrison in Prishtinë/Priština.
