

Fehmi (Muhamet) Lladrovci

(born 15/05/1956, Albanian from Gllanasellë/Gladno Selo, Glllogoc/ Glogovac municipality, member of KLA)

Xheve (Avdyll Krasniqi)**Lladrovci**

(born 1/06/1955, Albanian woman from Gllanasellë/Gladno Selo, Glllogoc/ Glogovac municipality, member of KLA)

Shefqet (Sabit) Zeka

(born 8/08/1977, Albanian from Prishtinë/Priština, worker, member of KLA)

Fatime (Zeqir) Hetemi

(born 18/12/1977, Albanian woman from Bistricë/Bistrica, Leposaviq/Leposavić municipality, member of KLA)

Fehmi studied mechanical engineering in Zagreb. He and his wife Xheve joined the National Movement for Kosovo Liberation in the 1980s. In 1985, Fehmi was sentenced in Serbia to 10 years in prison for seditious conspiracy. He served his term in Stara Gradiška [Croatia] and was released in 1991. When the war in Croatia broke out, Fehmi and Xheve joined the Croatian army. Fehmi held the rank of colonel. At the onset of the conflicts in Kosovo, they joined the KLA. Xheve was Commander of the KLA sanitation unit.

Fehmi and Xheve died on **22 September 1998** in clashes with Serb forces in **Gllanasellë/Gladno Selo**. Shefqet Zeka and Fatime Hetemi lost their lives on the same day. They were buried with military honours several days later, after Serb forces withdrew from the area, in the cemetery in Gllanasellë/Gladno Selo. Xheve was posthumously promoted to the rank of Major-General.

Ramadan (Islam) Muleta

(born 10/05/1954, Albanian from Korroticë e Epërme/Gornja Koretica, Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality, secretary in Korroticë e Epërme/Gornja Koretica Elementary School, three

children, member of KLA)

Bashkim (Tahir) Muleta

(born 11/12/1971, Albanian from Korroticë e Epërme/Gornja Koretica, Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality, member of KLA)

Besim (Rexhep) Muleta

(born 9/05/1975, Albanian from Korroticë e Epërme/Gornja Koretica, Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality, one child, member of KLA)

Muhamet (Brahim) Krasniqi

(born 5/10/1975, Albanian from Negroc/Negrovce, Glllogoc/Glogovac municipality, teacher, three children)

Ramadan and his nephew Besim and cousin Bashkim joined the KLA in late March 1998, after the murder of the Jashari family in Prekaz i Poshtëm/Donje Prekaze [see records] and the Ahmeti brothers in Likoshan/Likošane [see records]. Because of frequent Serb raids into the village and their ill-treatment of villagers, the residents of Korroticë e Epërme/Gornja Koretica left the village in early September, leaving only some KLA members behind. The Muleta family found refuge in the village of Sllatinë/Slatina. Besim's mother Fatë returned to Korroticë e Epërme/Gornja Koretica on **22 September 1998**; that was the last time she saw her son and cousins Ramadan and Baskim. Muhamet lived with his family in Negroc/Negrovce, where he worked as a school teacher. When Serb forces attacked this village on **25 September 1998**, his family fled into a nearby forest, whereas he said that he would go to Prishtinë/Priština. On 27 September 1998, Besim's parents Rexhep and Fatë left for Prishtinë/Priština to see their son. Along the way, they heard that fierce fighting had taken place around Korroticë e Epërme/Gornja Koretica. Having approached the village [**Korroticë e Epërme/Gornja Koretica**], they heard the voices of Serb soldiers and saw their vehicles near the quarry. They turned around and started walking back towards Sllatinë/Slatina. Some 20-25 minutes later, they came across four bodies – those of Besim, Ramadan, Bashkim and Mehmet, whom they identified by the ID card they found in his pocket. All four men had been
